Affected parties shall submit the evidence they wish the Board to consider a minimum of one (1) full business day prior to the date of the meeting. The affected party or applicant shall have the right to one (1) continuance provided the request is to address neighborhood concerns or new evidence, to hire legal coursel or a professional services consultant, or the applicant or affected party is mable to be represented at the hearing.
