4 RESOLUTION NO. 17-2021 OF THE CITY OF LAKE WORTH BEACH,  
5 FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF AN APPLICATION TO  
6 PALM BEACH COUNTY FOR FISCAL YEAR 2021-2022 COMMUNITY  
7 DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT FUNDS IN THE ESTIMATED AMOUNT  
8 OF \$266,560 FOR IMPROVEMENTS TO MEMORIAL PARK LOCATED AT  
9 6<sup>TH</sup> AVENUE SOUTH AND SOUTH A STREET WITHIN THE LAKE  
10 WORTH BEACH COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT  
11 TARGET AREA; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR  
12 OTHER PURPOSES.

14 WHEREAS, Palm Beach County, as an eligible Urban County, receives an annual  
15 statutory formula allocation of Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program  
16 funds from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD); and  
17

18 WHEREAS, the City participates in the Palm Beach County CDBG Urban County  
19 Program by entering into an Interlocal Agreement with Palm Beach County and is thereby  
20 eligible for receipt of its portion of the formula allocation of Fiscal Year 2021-2022 CDBG  
21 funds in an estimated amount of \$266,560; and

23 WHEREAS the aforementioned funding is subject to availability from HUD and  
24 approval by the Board of County Commissioners; and

26 WHEREAS, Palm Beach County has announced that the City can submit one  
27 application for the aforementioned Fiscal Year 2021-2022 Community Development  
28 Block Grant Program funding to be used for an eligible activity under the CDBG Program  
29 as set forth at 24 CFR Part 570 as allowed by the County; and

31 WHEREAS, public facilities and improvements is an eligible activity under CDBG  
32 Program regulations at 24 CFR 570.201(a); and  
33

34 WHEREAS the City intends to make necessary improvements to Memorial Park  
35 located at 6<sup>th</sup> Avenue South and South A Street; and

37 WHEREAS, the City will need to provide a local cost share in the estimated  
38 \$297,255 to make these planned improvements; and

40 WHEREAS, the service area of the City's proposed activity is located within the  
41 Lake Worth Beach CDBG Target Area and thereby meets a National Objective of the  
42 CDBG program of providing a benefit to low- and moderate-income persons; and

44 WHEREAS, the City desires to submit an application to Palm Beach County for  
45 Fiscal Year 2021-2022 CDBG funding in the estimated amount of \$266,560 for  
46 improvements to Memorial Park.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF LAKE WORTH BEACH, FLORIDA, that:

SECTION 1: The City Commission of the City of Lake Worth Beach, Florida, hereby authorizes the submission of an application to Palm Beach for Fiscal Year 2021-2022 CDBG funding in the estimated amount of \$266,560 for improvements to Memorial Park located at 6<sup>th</sup> Avenue South and South A Street.

SECTION 2: The City Commission of the City of Lake Worth Beach, Florida, hereby authorizes Michael Bornstein, City Manager, or his designee, to execute the City's application for Fiscal Year 2021-2022 CDBG funding from Palm Beach County.

SECTION 3: Upon execution of the resolution, one copy shall be provided to the Leisure Services Department Director. The fully executed original shall be maintained by the City Clerk as a public record of the City.

SECTION 4: This resolution shall become effective upon adoption.
