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Section 30. Time of Taking Effect. That this Act shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Governor, or upon its becoming a law without such approval.

CHAPTER 24649—(No. 1035)

HOUSE BILL NO. 1124

AN ACT to Prescribe and Define the Corporate Boundaries of the City of Lake Worth, a Municipal Corporation in Palm Beach County, Florida, to Repeal Laws in Conflict Herewith, and Providing a Referendum.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. The boundaries of the City of Lake Worth, a municipal corporation in Palm Beach County, Florida shall be as follows:

Beginning at the Southeast corner of the Northeast one-quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Thirty-three (33), Township Forty-four (44) South, Range Forty-three (43) East; thence West following the East and West center line of said Section (33) to the Southwest corner of the Northwest one-quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of said Section Thirty-three (33); thence North following the section line between Sections Thirty-two (32) and Thirty-three (33), and between Sections Twenty (20) and Twenty-one (21), and between Sections Sixteen (16) and Seventeen (17), all in Township Forty-four (44) South, Range Forty-three (43) East, to a point Five Hundred (500) feet South of the Northeast corner of Section Seventeen (17) in Township Forty-four (44) South, Range Forty-three (43) East; thence Easterly and parallel to the North line of Section Sixteen (16), in Township Forty-four (44) South, Range Forty-three (43) East, to the center of the Lake Worth Drainage District Canal E-4; thence Northeasterly following the center line

of said canal to the center line of the West Palm Beach Canal; thence Easterly following the Center line of the West Palm Beach Canal to the waters of Lake Worth; thence East to the middle of the Channel of Lake Worth; thence Southerly following the middle of the Channel of Lake Worth to the North side of the bridge crossing Lake Worth at the City of Lake Worth; thence Easterly following the North side of said bridge to the causeway; thence East to a point ten (10) feet West of the waters edge of the Atlantic Ocean at mean high tide; thence Southerly following a line ten (10) feet West of the waters edge of the Atlantic Ocean at mean high tide to the South boundary of that Ocean-front property now owned by the said City of Lake Worth; thence Westerly following said South boundary line to the Southeast corner of that property deeded to the Lake Worth Broadcasting Corporation as described in Deed Book 631 at page 155 Palm Beach County records; thence Northerly following the east boundary of said Lake Worth Broadcasting property to the Northeast corner thereof; thence Westerly following the North boundary of said Lake Worth Broadcasting property to the waters of Lake Worth; thence West to the middle of the channel of Lake Worth; thence Southerly following the middle of the channel of Lake Worth to the East and West center line of Section Thirty-four (34) in Township Forty-four (44) South, Range Forty-three (43) East; thence West following said center line to the point of beginning.

Section 2. All laws or parts of laws in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 3. This Act shall not become effective unless the same shall have been approved by a majority of the qualified electors of the City of Lake Worth, a municipal corporation in Palm Beach County, Florida, actually voting in an election called for such purpose. Such election shall be called by the City Commission of said City of Lake Worth within six months after this Act becomes a law and the ballots shall be arranged so that each elector may register either his approval or disapproval of this Act. The City Commission of said City shall canvass the returns and if a majority of the electors voting in said election have approved this Act, it shall thereupon become effective.

SENATE BILL NO. 837

AN ACT to Amend Chapter 14179 of the Legislature of the State of Florida for the Year 1929 Entitled: "An Act Repealing Chapter 10764, of the Legislature of the State of Florida for the Year 1925, Entitled "An Act to Abolish the Present Municipal Government of the Town of Lake Worth in Palm Beach County, Florida; to Create and Establish a New Municipality to be Known as the City of Lake Worth, in Palm Beach County, Florida; to Legalize and Validate the Ordinances of Said City of Lake Worth and Official Acts Thereunder; to Fix and Provide its Territorial Limits, Jurisdiction and Powers and the Jurisdiction and Powers of its Officers" Approved June 3, 1925, and Created and Establishing a Municipality Known as the City of Lake Worth, in Palm Beach County, Florida, Legalizing and Validating the Ordinances of Said City of Lake Worth and Official Acts Thereunder; Fixing and Providing its Territorial Limits, Jurisdiction and Powers and Jurisdiction and Powers of its Officers", by Amending Section Two Thereof Relating to the Boundaries of Said City.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. That Section 2 of Article 1 of Chapter 14179 of the Legislature of the State of Florida for the year 1929, entitled "An Act repealing Chapter 10764, of the Legislature of the State of Florida for the year 1925, entitled 'An Act to abolish the present municipal government of the Town of Lake Worth in Palm Beach County, Florida; to create and establish a new municipality to be known as the City of Lake Worth, in Palm Beach County, Florida; to legalize and validate the ordinances of said City of Lake Worth and official acts thereunder: To fix and provide its territorial limits, jurisdiction and powers and the jurisdiction and powers of its officers' approved June 3, 1925, and creating and establishing a municipality known as the City of Lake Worth,

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in Palm Beach County, Florida, legalizing and validating the ordinances of said City of Lake Worth and official acts thereunder; fixing and providing its territorial limits, jurisdiction and powers and jurisdiction and powers of its officers," is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 2. ARTICLE I. The boundaries of the City of Lake Worth in Palm Beach County, Florida, shall be as follows:

Beginning at a point at the intersection of the East and West Quarter Section line of Section Thirty-four (34), Township Forty-four (44) South, Range Forty-three (43) East in Palm Beach County, Florida, with the waters of Lake Worth on the West shore of Lake Worth; thence West along the Quarter section lines of Section Thirty-four (34) and Thirty-three (33) to the West quarter corner of Section Thirty-three (33), Township Forty-four (44) South, Range Forty-three (43) East; thence North on the section line between Sections Thirty-two (32) and Thirty-three (33), Sections Twenty-eight (28) and Twenty-nine (29), Sections Twenty (20) and Twenty-one (21), and Sections Sixteen (16) and Seventeen (17), all in Township Forty-four (44) South, Range Forty-three (43) East, to a point one thousand five feet (1005) South of the Northwest corner of said Section Sixteen (16) in Township Forty-four (44) South, Range Forty-three (43) East; thence East parallel to and one thousand five feet (1005 feet) South of the North boundary lines of Sections Sixteen (16) and Fifteen (15) in Township Forty-four (44) South, Range Forty-three (43) East to a point in the center of the channel of Lake Worth which is one thousand five feet (1005 feet) south of the North line of said Section Fifteen (15) produced; Thence South meandering the channel of Lake Worth to a point of intersection with the North line of Lake Avenue in the City of Lake Worth, if extended, thence East on said extended line of Lake Avenue to a point ten feet (10 feet) distant from the waters edge of the Atlantic Ocean at mean high tide; thence Southerly paralleling the waters edge of the Atlantic Ocean on a line ten feet (10) westerly thereof measured at mean high tide, to a point three hundred fifty feet (350 feet) South from the intersection of the Center line of Lake Avenue in the City of Lake Worth, Palm Beach County, Florida, produced, and the center line of the Ocean Boulevard, which is the South boundary line of the Casino property of the said City of Lake Worth as at present laid out and constituted; thence due West on the South line of said Casino

property and said line extended to the channel of Lake Worth; thence South meandering the Channel of Lake Worth to its intersection with the North line of Section Thirty-five (35), Township Forty-four (44) South, Range Forty-three (43) East; thence West to the shore of Lake Worth; thence South meandering the west shore of Lake Worth to the point of beginning.

Section 3. The purpose of the Legislature in describing the Easterly boundary of the land set forth in the preceding section as being ten feet Westerly of the mean highwater mark of the Atlantic Ocean is to make contiguous the land now located in the Town of Palm Beach, lying North and South of the above described property.

Section 4. This Act shall not become effective until a majority of the qualified voters of the City of Lake Worth voting on the same at a special election called for such purpose shall vote in favor thereof. Said election shall be held and conducted in substantial conformity as to manner of holding and conducting other elections in the City so far as the same is applicable. The form of ballot to be used at said election shall be fixed by the Commission of the City of Lake Worth, such election to be held at any time prior to the first day of June, A. D. 1936.

Section 5. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with the provisions of this Act are hereby repealed.

Section 6. This Act shall become effective immediately upon its being ratified as provided by Section Four of this Act.
