RESOLUTION NO. 41-2025 OF THE CITY OF LAKE WORTH BEACH, FLORIDA, APPROVING THE SUBMISSION OF AN APPLICATION FOR FUNDING UNDER THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT LEAD-BASED PAINT HAZARD REDUCTION GRANT PROGRAM; AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR HER DESIGNEE, TO EXECUTE THE GRANT APPLICATION; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

WHEREAS, housing constructed prior to 1978 is likely to contain lead-based paint; and

WHEREAS, exposure to lead-based paint remains a critical environmental health concern that contributes to developmental delays, learning disabilities and long-term neurological damage in children; and

WHEREAS, approximately seventy-five percent of housing units in the City of Lake Worth Beach ("City") were built before the 1978 federal ban on lead-based paint; and

WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development ("HUD") provides funding under the HUD Lead-Based Paint Hazard ("LHR") Grant Program to eliminate this health risk; and

WHEREAS, the City, as an eligible applicant, desires to apply for funding under the LHR Grant Program to help eliminate this health risk in its housing stock; and

WHEREAS, this serves a valid public purpose.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF LAKE WORTH BEACH, FLORIDA, that:

<u>SECTION 1</u>: The City Commission of the City of Lake Worth Beach, Florida, hereby approves the submission of an application to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development for funding its Lead-Based Paint Hazard Reduction Grant Program to assist with the elimination of this health risk in the City's housing stock.

<u>SECTION 2</u>: The City Commission of the City of Lake Worth Beach, Florida, hereby authorizes the Mayor, or her designee, to execute any programmatic documents related to the City's funding application

<u>SECTION 3</u>. Upon execution of the resolution, one copy shall be forwarded to the City Manager's Office. The fully executed original shall be maintained by the City Clerk as a public record of the City

SECTION 4: This resolution shall become effective upon adoption.
