TITLE:

Memorandum of Understanding with the Solid Waste Authority of Palm Beach County for debris management

SUMMARY:

This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with the Solid Waste Authority (SWA) of Palm Beach County establishes a partnership with the City in an effort to adhere to Senate Bill 180 Emergencies.

BACKGROUND AND JUSTIFICATION:

Senate Bill 180 Emergencies makes various changes relating to the preparation and response activities of state and local government when emergencies impact the state. The bill contains the following language in regard to emergency preparedness and response duties and directives of local governments:

“Directs each county and municipality to apply to the DEP (Department of Environmental Protection) for authorization of at least one debris management site and encourages local governments to add an addendum to existing solid waste contracts for the collection of storm-generated debris.”

The MOU being brought forth between the City and SWA addresses the intent of this portion of SB 180 Emergencies directly.
