

**RESOLUTION NO. 02-2026 OF THE CITY OF LAKE WORTH BEACH,
FLORIDA, ADOPTING CITY POLICY FOR FACILITY FEE WAIVER
REQUESTS; AND PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS, SEVERABILITY,
AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE**

WHEREAS, The City of Lake Worth Beach recognizes that public facilities are vital to community engagement, cultural enrichment, and civic pride; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission, aims to support non-profit, charitable, and community-based initiatives that serve the public interest by granting partial or full fee waivers for facility rentals when justified by measurable social, economic, or community benefits; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission desires to adopt the proposed policy to establish criteria and procedures for consistent evaluation of facility fee waiver requests while ensuring equitable community access and maintaining fiscal responsibility and transparency in City resource management; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission finds that the creation of “The City of Lake Worth Beach Facility Fee Waiver Request Policy” serves a valid public purpose.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LAKE WORTH BEACH, FLORIDA, that:

Section 1. The foregoing recitals and findings are incorporated into the Resolution as true statements.

Section 2. The City Commission of the City of Lake Worth Beach, Florida, hereby approves and adopts the “The City of Lake Worth Beach Facility Fee Waiver Request Policy” in the form attached hereto as **Exhibit A**.

Section 3. All resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict herewith are repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 4. Should any section or provision of this resolution or portion hereof, any paragraph, sentence or word be declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such decision shall not affect the remainder of this resolution.

Section 5. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage.
