RESOLUTION NO. 29-2020 OF THE CITY OF LAKE WORTH BEACH, FLORIDA, ADOPTING A TENTATIVE OPERATING MILLAGE RATE OF 5.4945 MILLS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2020-2021; ESTABLISHING A DATE AND TIME FOR THE FIRST HEARING ON THE TENTATIVE BUDGET AND PROPOSED MILLAGE RATE; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO SUBMIT THE REQUIRED FORMS TO THE PALM BEACH COUNTY PROPERTY APPRAISER; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, pursuant to §200.065, Florida Statutes, the City Commission is required to advise the County Property Appraiser of its tentative millage rate, its rolled-back millage rate, and the date, time and place at which a public hearing will be held to consider the proposed millage rate and the City’s tentative budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LAKE WORTH BEACH, FLORIDA as follows:

Section 1. The City Commission hereby adopts a tentative operating millage rate of 5.4945 mills for General Operating Budget purposes for Fiscal Year 2020-2021; which remains the same as last year.

Section 2. The City Commission hereby establishes Thursday, September 10, 2020, at 6:00 p.m. as the date and time of the first hearing on the tentative budget and proposed millage rate. The public hearing shall be held at City Hall, 7 North Dixie Highway, Lake Worth Beach, Florida 33460. Due to the pending COVID-19 pandemic, the meeting may be conducted via technological means. The City will provide additional information on how the meeting will be conducted on its website.

Section 3. The City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to submit forms DR-420 (Certification of Taxable Value), DR-420TIF (Tax Increment Adjustment Worksheet) and DR-420 MM-P (Municipality Maximum Millage Levy Calculation) to the Palm Beach County Property Appraiser's Office.
