



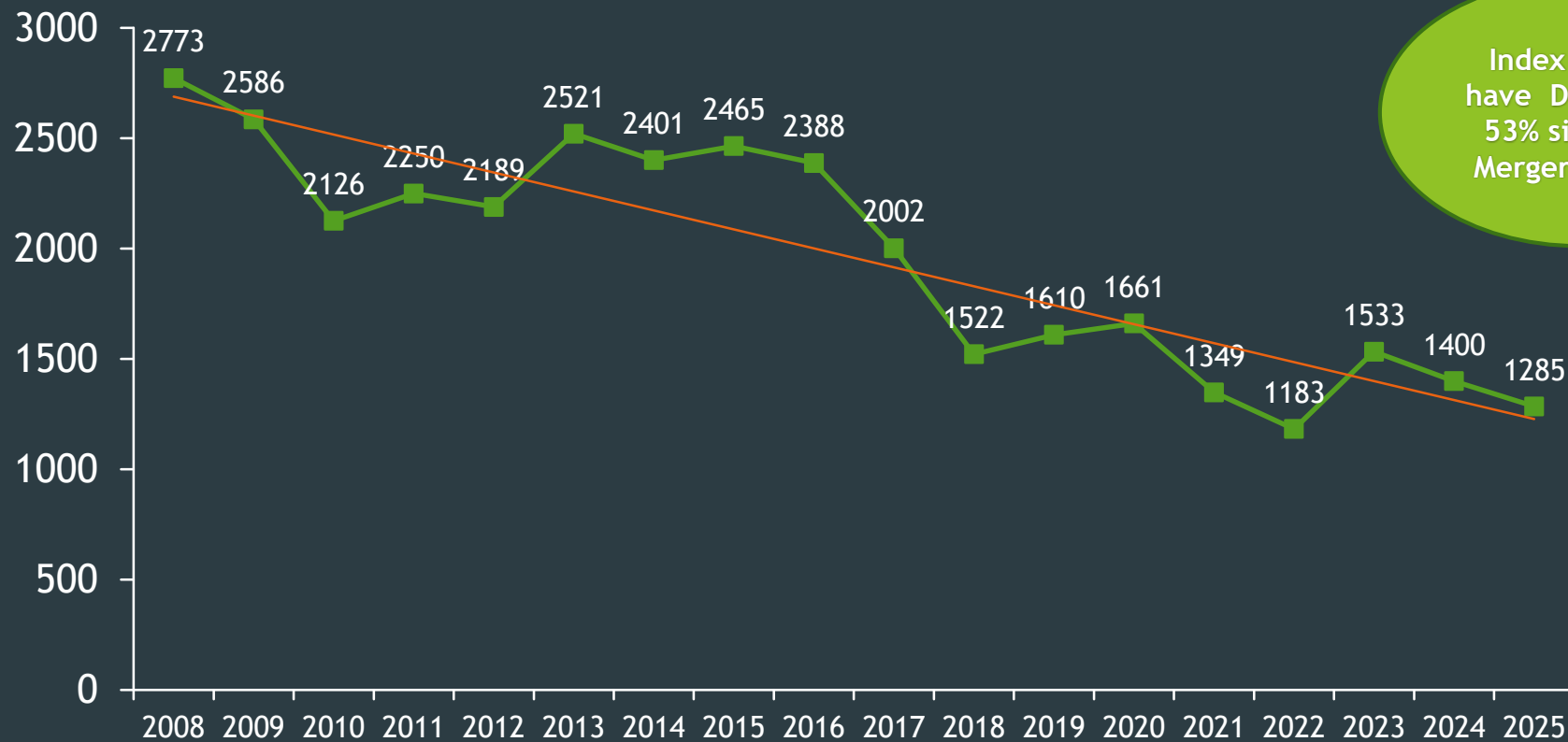

Total Index Crimes - 2008 to 2025

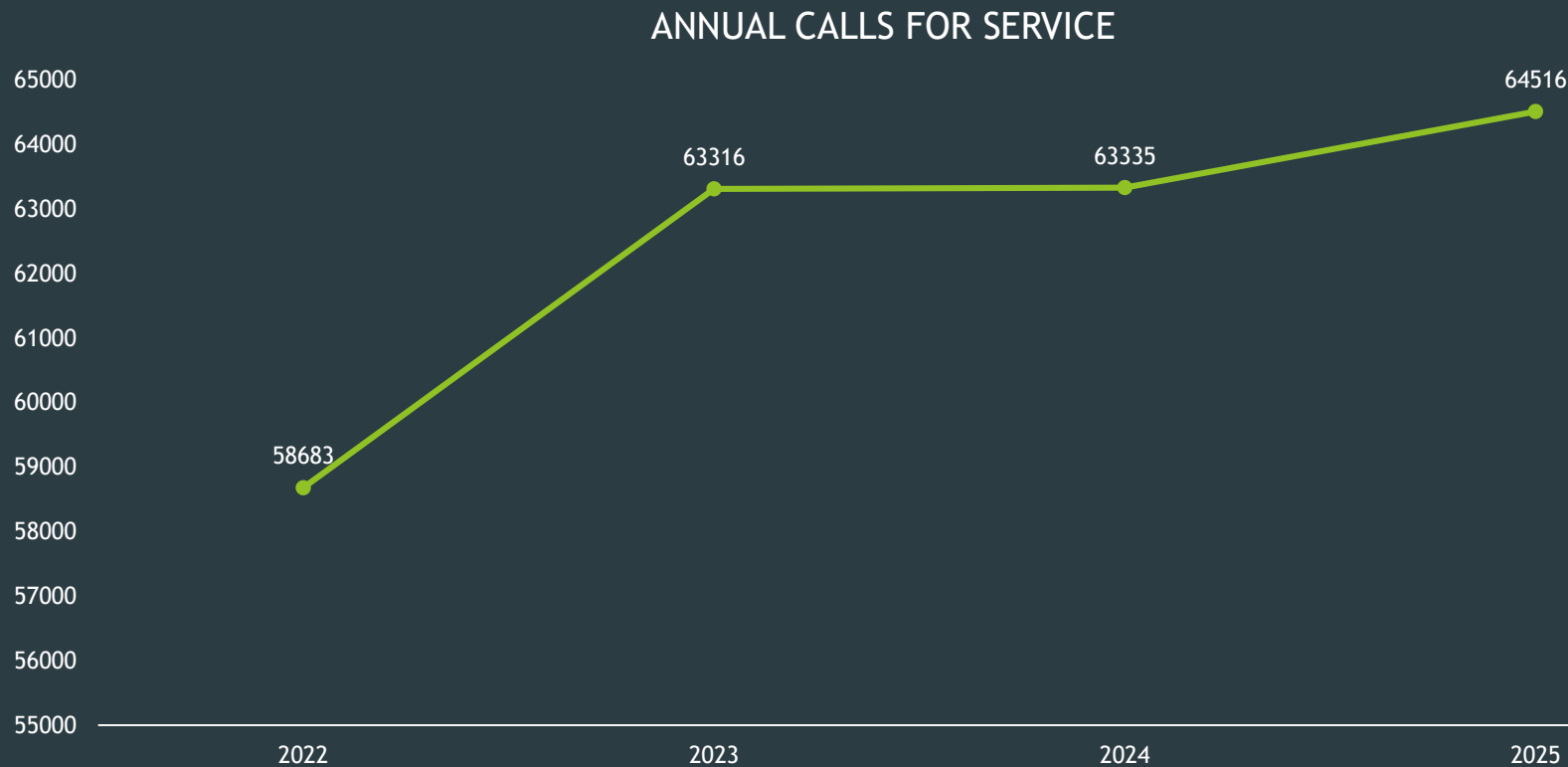

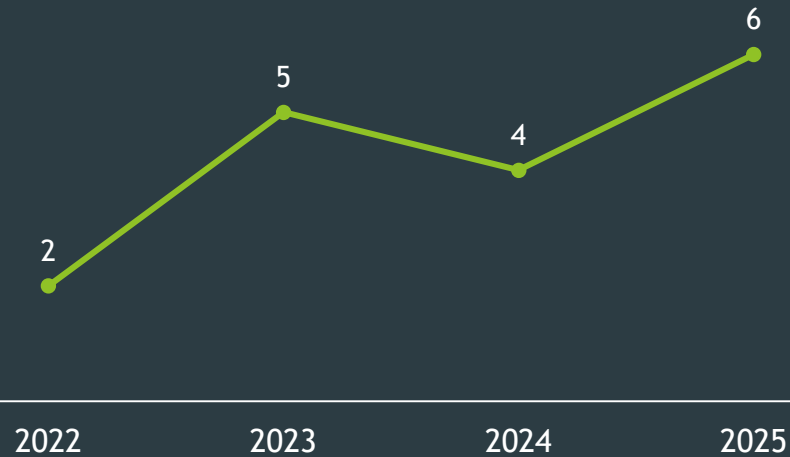

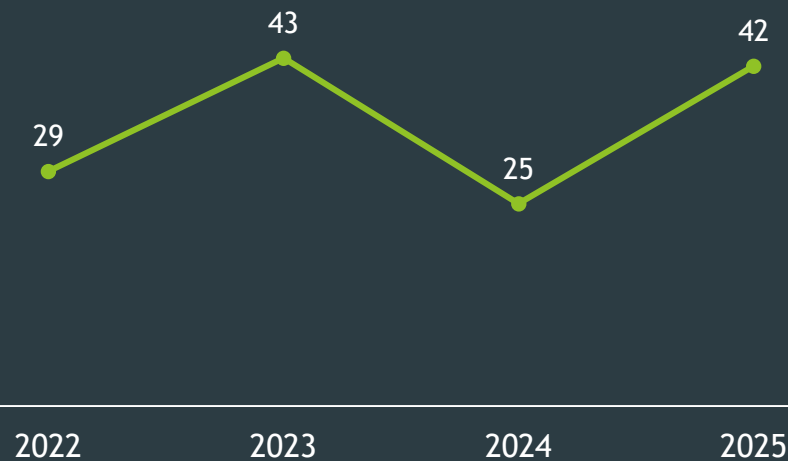

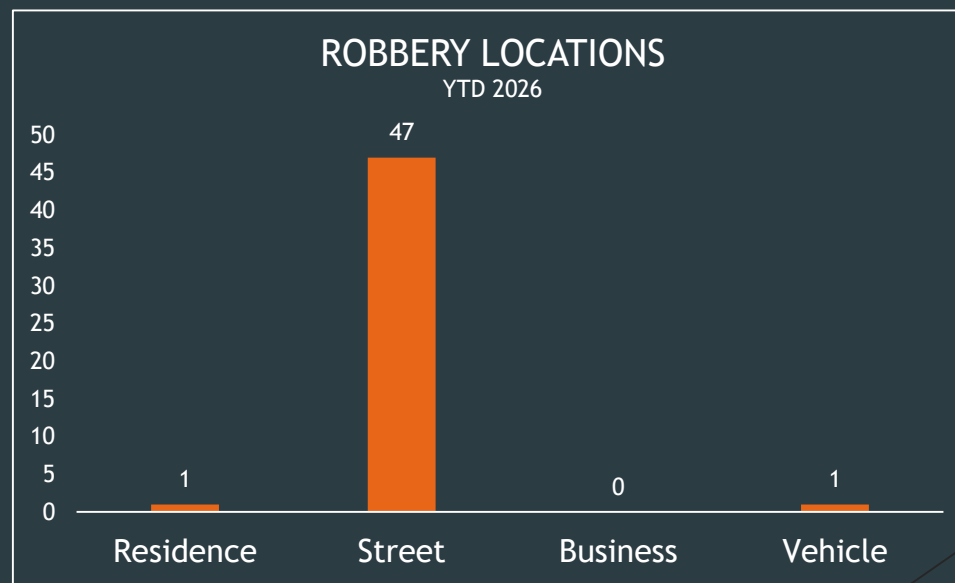

Robbery Incidents

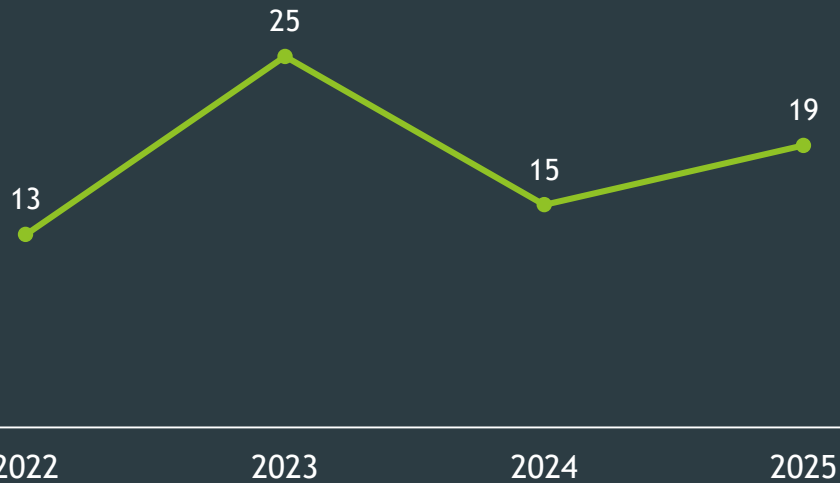

SHOOTING TRENDS

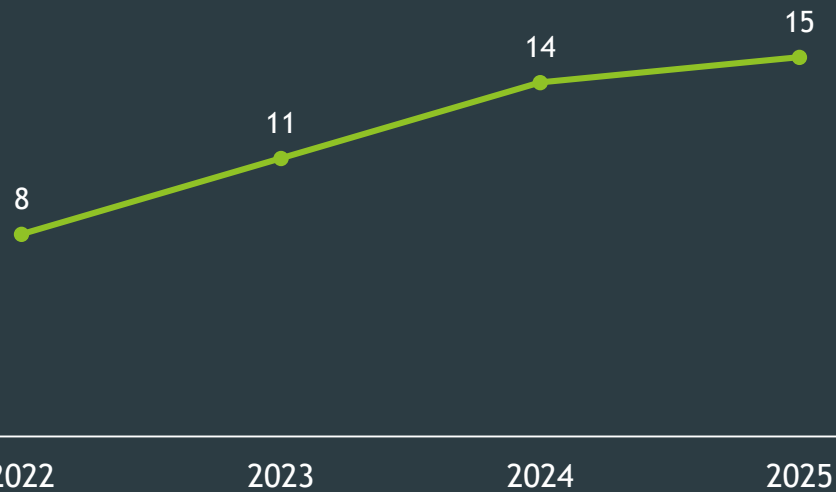

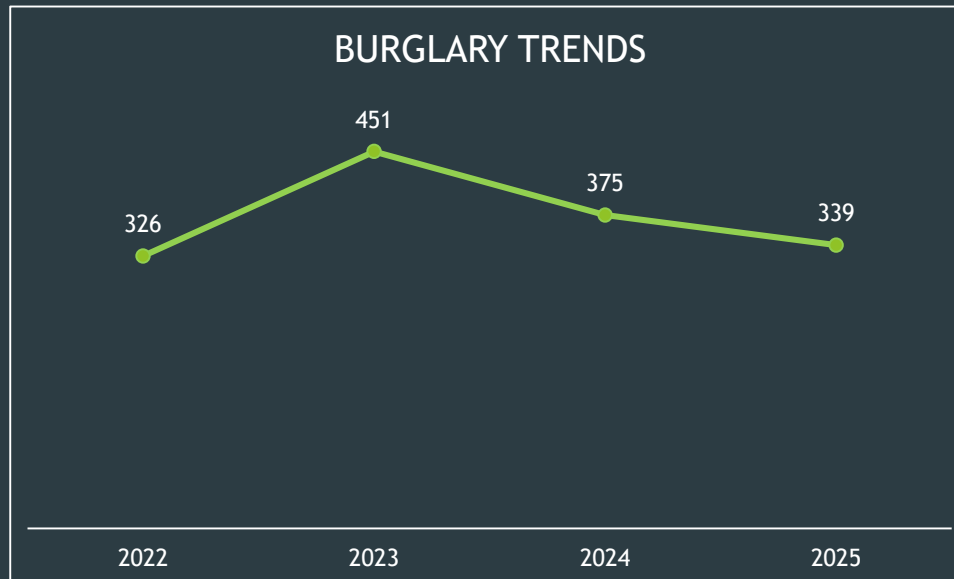


Stabbing

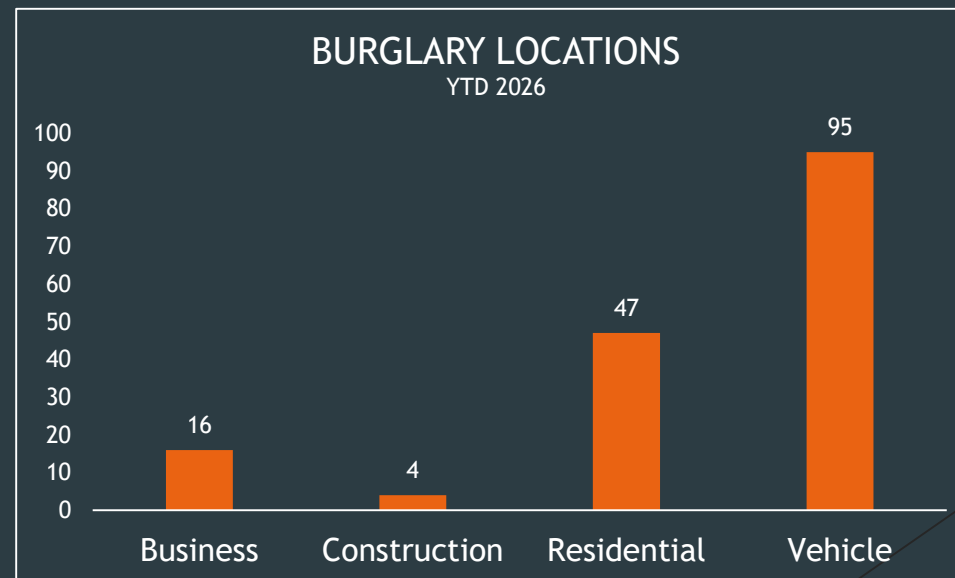

Burglary Incidents

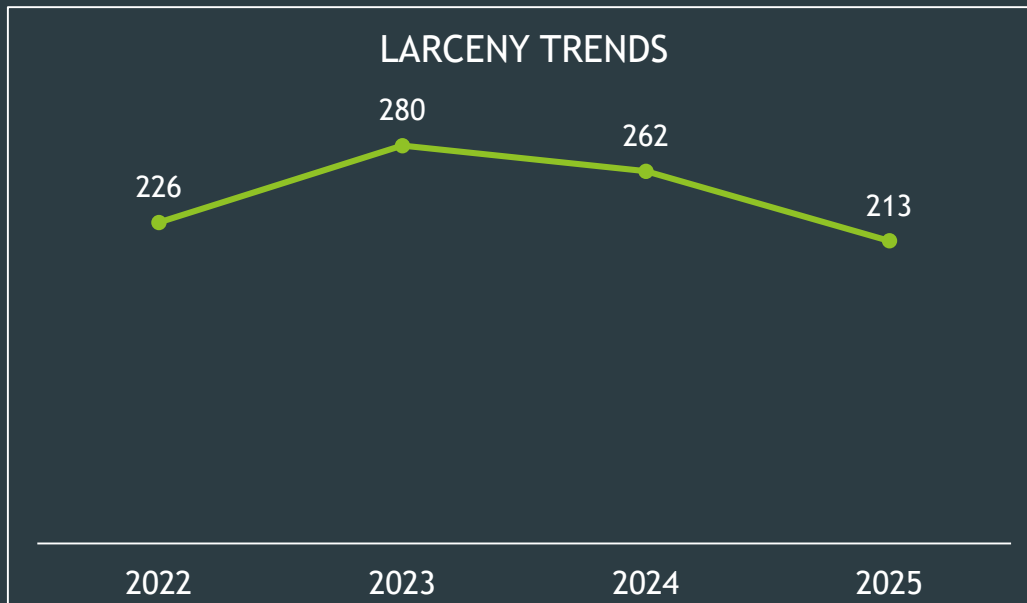

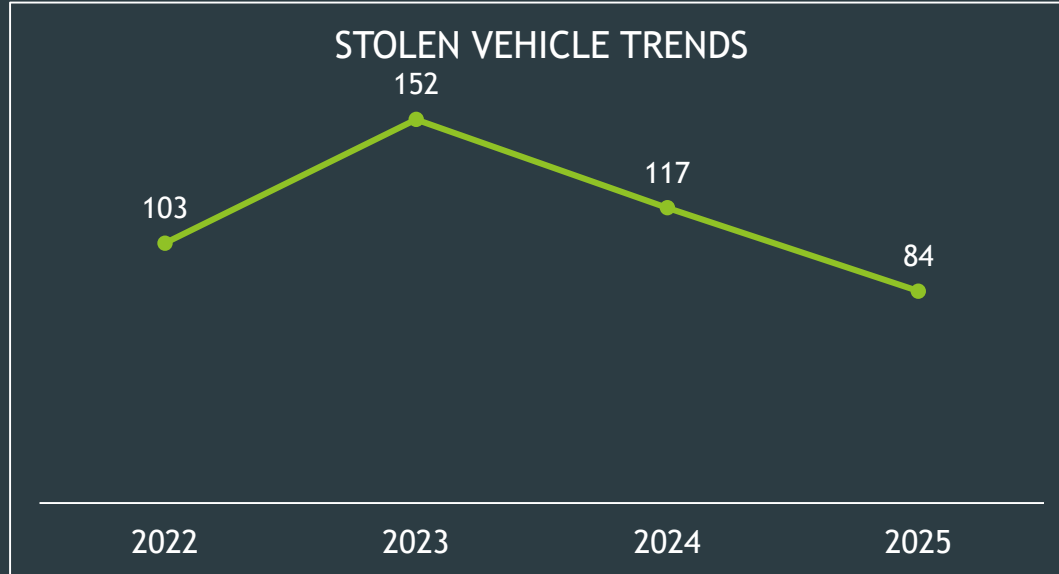

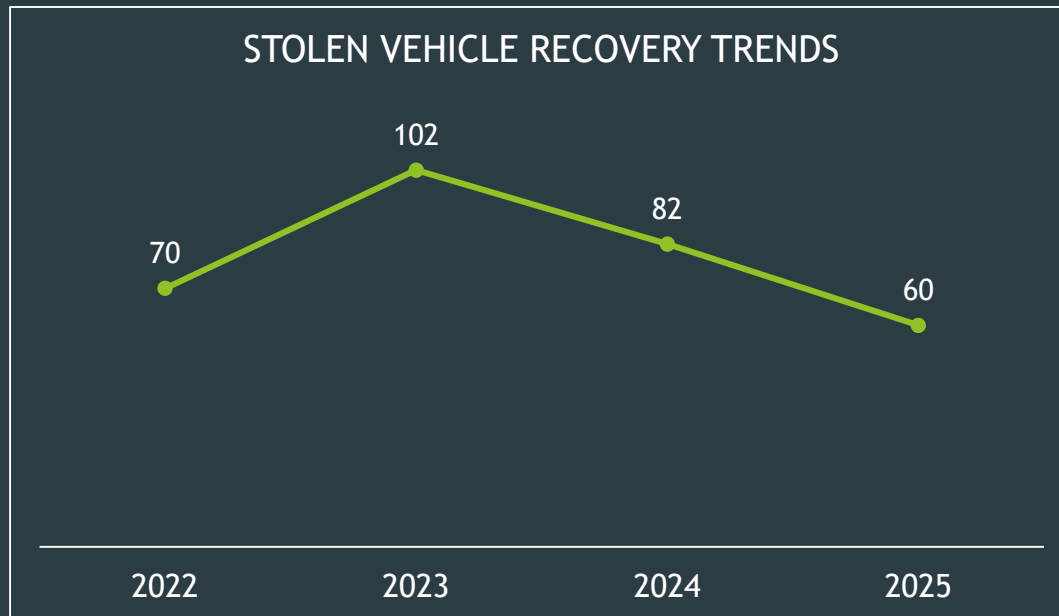

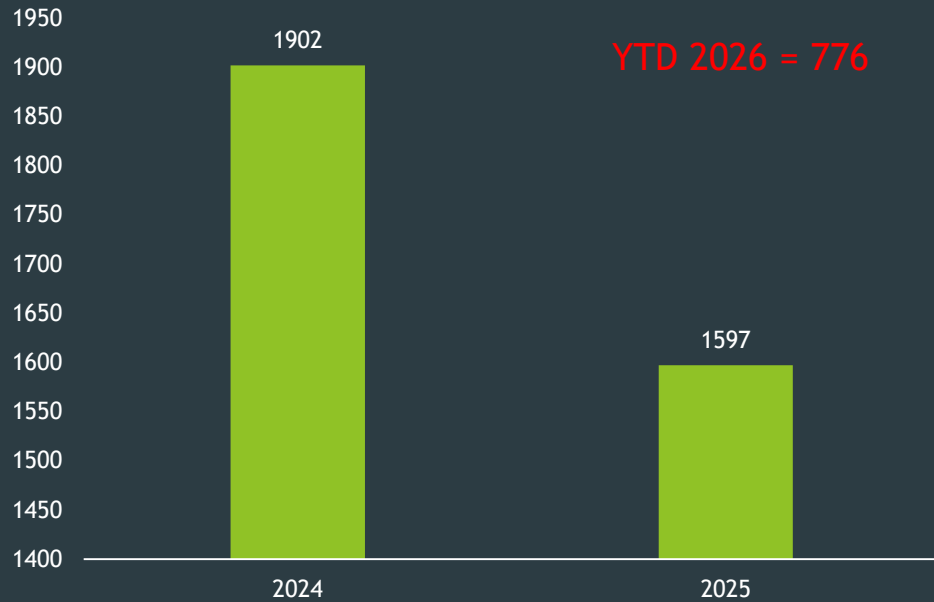

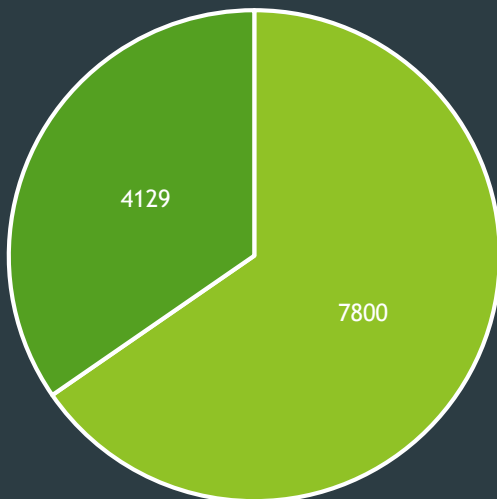
