The City of Lake Worth Beach is submitting an application for the Palm Beach Transportation Planning Agency's 2020 Transportation Alternatives cycle. The scope of the above referenced project will involve the addition and improvement of ADA ramps throughout the entire City.

Voters approved a four year infrastructure bond back in November of 2016, but there are still numerous City infrastructure needs in excess of available funding. While the bond program is providing a much needed boost, it only addresses about a third of the City. The proposed project will help address ADA issues in areas not covered under the bond by providing the installation of new curb ramps in locations where they are currently damaged or missing all together.

As discussed in the January 7th, 2020 pre-application meeting with TPA / FDOT staff, if selected for funding the City will administer and construct the project. The City is excited to submit this 2020 Transportation Alternatives application and looks forward to the process that lies ahead.
