

RESOLUTION NO. 12-2020 OF THE CITY OF LAKE WORTH BEACH, FLORIDA, ENDORSING THE CITY'S APPLICATIONS FOR THE PALM BEACH COUNTY TRANSPORTATION PLANNING AGENCY 2020 LOCAL INITIATIVES PROGRAM FOR SOUTH EAST COAST STREET AND SOUTH "H" STREET FROM LAKE AVENUE TO 6TH AVENUE SOUTH INCLUDING THE EAST/WEST STREET SEGMENTS FROM S. EAST COAST STREET TO SOUTH DIXIE HIGHWAY (1ST AVENUE SOUTH, 2ND AVENUE SOUTH, 3RD AVENUE SOUTH, 4TH AVENUE SOUTH AND 5TH AVENUE SOUTH) AS WELL AS THE 2020 TRANSPORTATION ALTERNATIVES PROGRAM FOR CITY-WIDE ADA RAMP ADDITIONS AND IMPROVEMENTS AND COMMITTING TO FUNDING RELATED OPERATIONS AND MAINTENANCE; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, on February 28, 2020, the City of Lake Worth Beach (City) submitted an application to the Palm Beach County Transportation Planning Agency (TPA) for the 2020 Local Initiatives and Transportation Alternatives Programs for the City's S. East Coast Street / South "H" Street project (Project) and City-wide ADA ramp improvements;

WHEREAS, the Project scope for the Local Initiatives program includes the area from Lake Avenue to 6th Avenue South and includes the east/west street segments from South East Coast Street to South Dixie Highway (1st Avenue South, 2nd Avenue South, 3rd Avenue South, 4th Avenue South and 5th Avenue South) and the Project scope for the Transportation Alternatives program includes City-wide ADA ramp improvements;

WHEREAS, the Local Initiatives Project proposes to repurpose overall roadway and eliminate lanes by transitioning from two-way to one-way road segments, add dedicated bicycle lanes, add new or modify existing sidewalk, correct existing drainage issues, add valley gutter or Type F curb and gutter, widen existing landscape or green space, add landscape or green space in locations there currently is none, add on-street parking, add pedestrian lighting, and add pedestrian friendly amenities such as benches, trash cans, and bicycle racks throughout and the Transportation Alternatives Project proposes the addition and improvement of ADA ramps in all four City Districts;

WHEREAS, the Projects are necessary to address needed repairs in the City's infrastructure in the Project areas;

WHEREAS, the City Commission has reviewed the Projects and find such Projects serve a valid public purpose and is in the best interest of the City's health, safety and welfare.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LAKE WORTH BEACH, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1: Recitals. The foregoing recitals are incorporated into this resolution as true and correct statements.

SECTION 2: Endorsement. The City of Lake Worth Beach City Commission hereby endorses the City's South East Coast Street / South "H" Street and City-wide ADA Additions and Improvements projects as submitted to the Palm Beach County Transportation Planning Agency for the 2020 Local Initiatives and Transportation Alternatives Programs.

SECTION 3: Funding. The City of Lake Worth Beach City Commission hereby commits to funding the related operations and maintenance of the City's South East Coast Street / South "H" Street and City-wide ADA Ramp Additions and Improvements projects as submitted to the Palm Beach County Transportation Planning Agency for the 2020 Local Initiatives and Transportation Alternatives Programs.

SECTION 4: Effective Date. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage.

SECTION 5: Copy. The City Clerk shall provide a copy of this resolution to the Palm Beach County Transportation Planning Agency as required for the City's East Coast Street / South "H" Street and City-wide ADA Ramp Additions and Improvements projects as submitted to the Palm Beach County TPA for the 2020 Local Initiatives and Transportation Alternatives Programs.
