TITLE:

Purchase Order with EMCI Wireless for Public Works Solid Waste Radios Purchase & Setup

SUMMARY:

This Purchase Order authorizes the City to purchase 34 XPR 2500 40w 128 CH Mobile Radios from Electronic Maintenance & Communications, Inc (EMCI Wireless) through Sourcewell Motorola Contract No. 042021-MOT at a cost not to exceed \$56,410.13.

BACKGROUND AND JUSTIFICATION:

The Solid Waste and Recycling Division is actively engaged in the collection of all of the City's garbage, trash, vegetation and recycling materials. As part of the management of the Solid Waste operation, the Division needs 34 XPR 2500 40w 128 CH Mobile Radios to be purchased and installed to be utilized for the Division's solid waste collection and emergency mitigation efforts. These radios will be purchased from EMCI Wireless through Sourcewell Motorola Contract No. 042021-MOT at a cost not to exceed \$56,410.13 as the CITY's Procurement Policy and Code authorizes the purchases of goods and services through cooperative Agreements.
