Electric Utility Easement between Bridge Holding, LLC and the City of Lake Worth Beach

SUMMARY:

Bridge Holding, LLC will dedicate a perpetual, unrestricted and nonexclusive Utility Easement to the City of Lake Worth Beach.

BACKGROUND AND JUSTIFICATION:

Bridge Holding, LLC, the developer of Lake Worth Station, a multi-family residential facility containing approximately 90 dwelling units, is granting to the City of Lake Worth Beach a Utility Easement. This ten (10) feet wide and forty-one 92/100 (41.92) feet long easement is located along the south side of 10th Ave. North adjacent to the alley east of North G Street. The City of Lake Worth Beach Electric Utilities facilities are to be placed underground in the provided easement. The project consists of electric distribution primary conductors routed within underground conduits to a pad-mount transformer.
