

RESOLUTION NO. 07-2026 OF THE CITY OF LAKE WORTH BEACH, FLORIDA, APPROVING THE CALENDAR YEAR 2026 AGREEMENT FOR VOTE PROCESSING EQUIPMENT USE AND ELECTION SERVICES WITH THE PALM BEACH COUNTY SUPERVISOR OF ELECTIONS; DESIGNATING THE CITY'S CANVASSING BOARD FOR THE MARCH 2026 ELECTION; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, each year, the City of Lake Worth Beach enters an agreement with the Palm Beach County Supervisor of Elections for vote processing equipment use and election services; and

WHEREAS, the Palm Beach County Supervisor of Elections has provided the City with an agreement for calendar year 2026, which includes the March 2026 municipal election; and

WHEREAS, the City of Lake Worth Beach's annual Municipal General Election is set for Tuesday, March 10, 2026, pursuant to the City Charter, Article III, Section 2; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the City Commission to designate the Palm Beach County Canvassing Board to serve as the City's Canvassing Board for the City's Municipal General Election as offered by the Supervisor of Elections; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission has determined that entering the 2026 Agreement with the Palm Beach County Supervisor of Elections and designating the Canvassing Board for the 2026 Municipal Election as set forth herein serves a valid public purpose and is in the best interests of the City of Lake Worth Beach.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LAKE WORTH BEACH, FLORIDA, that

Section 1. The foregoing recitals are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this resolution.

Section 2. The 2026 Agreement for Vote Processing Equipment Use and Election Services with the Palm Beach County Supervisor of Elections is hereby approved and confirmed and the Mayor is authorized to execute the same.

Section 3 The City Commission hereby designates the County Canvassing Board to serve as the City's Canvassing Board for the Municipal General Election scheduled for Tuesday, March 10, 2026.

Section 4. This resolution shall become effective upon its adoption.
