TITLE:

Bryant Park Fitness Court Design

SUMMARY:

The Leisure Services Department was approved for Capital Improvement Projects AP2403 and AP2602 for the Fitness Park Installation at South Bryant Park in the FY26 Budget and is presenting a design concept for a Bryant Park Fitness Court.

BACKGROUND AND JUSTIFICATION:

At South Bryant Park the existing fitness equipment and damaged shade structure have reached their life cycle. All of the fitness pieces as well as the shade structure are rusted and deteriorating due to their age and exposure to the salt-water environment. One fitness station was fully removed due to damage and multiple other components have been replaced in the last few years for safety. In addition, due to the condition of the shade structure the manufacturer does not recommend a replacement fabric option as the frame still needs substantial repairs.

Capital Improvement Projects AP2403 and AP2602 were approved for \$75,000 and \$125,000 for a total of \$200,000. The Leisure Services Department has been in contact with National Fitness Campaign Fitness Court which promotes building community through a mobile app, local artist program and sponsorship support to provide design options for a new outdoor fitness court. An upgraded design called the Oceanfront Package includes hot dip galvanizing all steel structures (or replacing steel with stainless steel) and elements of the Fitness Court, upgrading all equipment and wall anchors to stainless steel options, and added protection against galvanic corrosion. This outdoor fitness area would provide an opportunity for countless exercises on seven various pieces and use of a digital application.

Stuart Sword ,Leisure Services Assistant Director and Chris Hana, Parks Superintendent, were guest speakers at the Bryant Park Neighborhood Association meeting in December and presented the design concept to attendees and received support.

Approval is being sought for the proposed design of the Fitness Court. Upon approval, the design will be presented at a future meeting along with a recommended contract for services with the National Fitness Campaign for the installation and implementation of the Fitness Court..
