Affected parties shall submit the evidence they wish the City Commission to consider a minimum of one (1) full business day prior to the date of the meeting Affected parties, whether individually or collectively and irrespective of the number of affected parties, shall have the right to request one (1) continuance provided that the request is to: address neighborhood concerns or new evidence, hire legal counsel or a professional services consultant, or is unable to be represented at the hearing.
