TOPICVillage Budgetary Contract – Public Safety

BACKGROUND BRIEF:

PUBLIC SAFETY: Historically the Village has demanded that the amount of TIF proceeds/budget that is represented by the capture of increased revenue earned under the police millage levy (meaning the funding lost to the police by the lawful operation of the Village approved TIF plan) be returned to the Village. This is not only an improper use of TIF, but against all statutory authority and statutory interpretation. The Executive Director and the Chief have acknowledged the illegality of the historic demand and have assessed how the DDA may still be an active part and support of the Chief's new approach to public safety. The support of an additional officer and collaborated code enforcement services have bene included in the form of a contract for that purpose. The attached contract was prepared by the Police Chief, without assistance from Village Council, and is proposed for acceptance by the DDA. It is in an acceptable form and contains those two areas of participation important to the DDA's mission under the adopted TIF Plan.

FINANCIAL IMPACT:

The contracted cost for the Public Safety services offered by contract is \$103,000. This is included in our budget.

RECOMMENDED MOTION:

Move to approve the ENHANCED PUBLIC SAFETY AGREEMENT, as presented, authorizing the Executive Director to prepare an executory copy and sign the same on behalf of the DDA.
