



## COUNCIL ACTION SUMMARY SHEET

**MEETING DATE:** April 27<sup>th</sup>, 2026

**TOPIC:** Acceptance of donated funds from LOLA to support attendance of the Michigan Sheriffs Association (MSA) Marine Training for LOPD.

### BACKGROUND BRIEF:

On April 17, 2026, the Lake Orion Police Department was notified by the Lake Orion Lake Association (LOLA) that it approved a \$1,300 donation to help support the attendance of two marine officers at an advanced Marine Training Academy in Holland, Michigan. The donation will help cover tuition, lodging, meals, and transportation expenses associated with the training.

The academy provides advanced instruction in key areas of marine enforcement and safety, including Marine Safety Laws, arrest powers and limitations, navigation, officer safety on the water, trailering and towing, search and rescue operations, boat handling, accident investigation, and boat inspections. This training will further strengthen the knowledge and capabilities of LOPD personnel assigned to marine operations and enhance the department's ability to respond effectively to boating incidents and emergencies on Lake Orion.

This marks the second consecutive year LOLA has provided financial support for this training opportunity. Their continued partnership has helped expand training access for both police officers and reserve officers, strengthening the department's marine safety efforts and providing a lasting benefit to the Lake Orion community.

### FINANCIAL IMPACT:

Donation supplements the training and travel budget, allowing 2 additional personnel to attend. No unbudgeted impact.

### RECOMMENDED MOTION:

Motion to accept a \$1,300 donation from the Lake Orion Lake Association (LOLA) to support Marine Training Academy attendance for Lake Orion Police Department personnel and to approve Budget Amendment BA-2026-207-003 increasing 207-000-694-000 (Miscellaneous Revenue) by \$1,300, 207-301-957-000 (Education and Training) by \$400, and 207-301-863-000 (Travel Expense) by \$900.
