TOPIC: Approval of Special Event – Lake Orion Police Association 2026 Car Show

BACKGROUND BRIEF:

The Lake Orion Police Association (LOPA) is a non-profit organization composed of officers and volunteers from the Lake Orion Police Department. The association's core mission is to foster community trust, build positive relationships with local youth, and support vulnerable residents through targeted charitable initiatives. By donating their off-duty time, LOPA members actively strengthen the bond between law enforcement and the village of Lake Orion.

LOPA drives community impact through several key programs, including "Kids and Kops" interaction nights and the annual "Shop with a Hero" holiday event. The association directly supports education by providing classroom supplies to Blanche Sims Elementary, funding a student school lunch program, and awarding scholarships to future law enforcement students. In addition, LOPA coordinates with local businesses to provide property maintenance and assistance to low-income families and senior citizens.
