TOPIC First Reading of Ordinance Adopting the Recodified Code of Ordinances

BACKGROUND BRIEF:

The Village has completed a comprehensive recodification of its Code of Ordinances as part of its transition from American Legal Publishing to CivicPlus as the Village's codification service provider. The recodification process involved a thorough review of the Village's existing code, incorporating all ordinances adopted since the last codification update, reorganizing chapters and sections where necessary, correcting formatting inconsistencies, and updating statutory and internal references to improve usability and accessibility.

Transitioning to CivicPlus will provide the Village with enhanced online access to its Code of Ordinances, improved search functionality, and a more efficient process for maintaining future ordinance updates. The recodified code has been prepared to ensure that the Village's ordinances are presented in a clear, organized, and user-friendly format for elected officials, staff, residents, businesses, and legal counsel.

In accordance with the codification process and applicable legal requirements, the Village Council must adopt the recodified Code of Ordinances by ordinance.

The purpose of this agenda item is to conduct the first reading of the ordinance. Following the first reading, the ordinance will be brought back to the Village Council for a second reading and consideration of adoption at a subsequent meeting.
