TOPIC NOTA 2026-2033 First Amended and Restated Intergovernmental Contracted Services Agreement

BACKGROUND BRIEF:

Council is scheduled to consider approving the North Oakland Transportation Authority Intergovernmental Contracted Services Agreement. The Agreement establishes NOTA and its board of directors, outlines the powers of the board and the services to be provided by NOTA, identifies NOTA's funding sources, and establishes the membership and voting rights of each participating community, as well as other necessary provisions governing the operations of the Authority. The current agreement expires on December 31, 2025.

Attached is the proposed Agreement for Council's review and consideration. The Village Attorney has reviewed the Agreement and finds it to be acceptable as to legality in form and content.

FINANCIAL IMPACT:

NOTA, through Oakland County levies a transit tax of 0.9407 mil in the Village. The Village also disburses its SMART Municipal Credit funds of about \$2,900 annually to NOTA.

To approve the 2026-2033 North Oakland Transportation Authority (NOTA) First Amended and Restated Intergovernmental Contracted Services Agreement and to authorize the Village President to execute the agreement on behalf of the Village.
