Over the life of the DDA, since 1986, we have directly contributed to the Operational cost of the Village, supporting Police, DPW, Administration, and Staff. Our annual general fund contribution has averaged \$234,000, resulting in a total investment in the safety and general operations of more than:

Just since 2006, only half our life, we have invested more than **\$6,500,000** in the infrastructure and life of our Village. Examples include:
