KAYAK AND PADDLE BOARD KIOSK PROPOSAL FOR GREEN'S PARK

HOW IT WORKS:

This is a locking rack system for kayaks and paddle boards, plus a locker system that houses life jackets and paddles.

The customer agrees to all the liability waivers on the touch screen, selects how many hours they want to rent it for, and then swipes their debit/credit card. The door to their PPE opens and the watercraft unlocks and they're good to go!

To return the equipment, the customer swipes the same card, and the machine matches the last four numbers and re-opens/unlocks their spaces. The items are then returned to their original locations.

The machine tells the customer if they have not closed the locker door or locked the kayak in its space properly, computes how long they've had the items out, and up-charges if necessary.

Customer receipts can be received by emailing or texting the number on the machine with the last four digits of the card that was used.

NOTE: The machine is programmed so that it will not allow rentals between dusk and dawn, complying with safe boating regulations.

KAYAK KIOSK FAQs

HOW BIG IS EACH UNIT?

Each module is 5 feet wide by 4 feet deep. The kayak racks are 4 feet by 4 feet. The lockers are approximately 15 inches wide by 2 feet deep.

HOW STURDY IS THE MACHINE?

The machine is all steel construction and is very sturdy.

HOW DO THE MACHINES WORK?

They have a 4G secure and encrypted telemetry system that finds the strongest cell signal in the area. They also have solar powered systems where electrical outlets are unavailable.

REMOTE OPERATION?

The operator (Lake Orion Bike & Adventure Co.) can take control of the machine to open doors, manually return equipment or troubleshoot. Sometimes, people accidentally shut the doors before they get all their gear out, or they forget their keys in the locker when they return. To combat this, the manufacturer has added a secondary router so that the owner/operator can remotely take control of the machines from their computer or phone and re-open the lockers, unlock kayaks, or manually return forgotten items.

COMPENSATION TO THE VILLAGE OF LAKE ORION?

Lake Orion Bike & Adventure will provide compensation for patron access to the Village-owned park/parking lot at a cost of \$2.00 per person (per rental). Remittance will be paid on the last day of each month, with all payments completed in full by November 30th of each year.

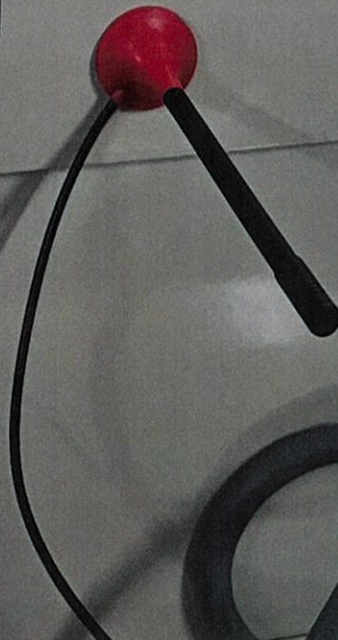

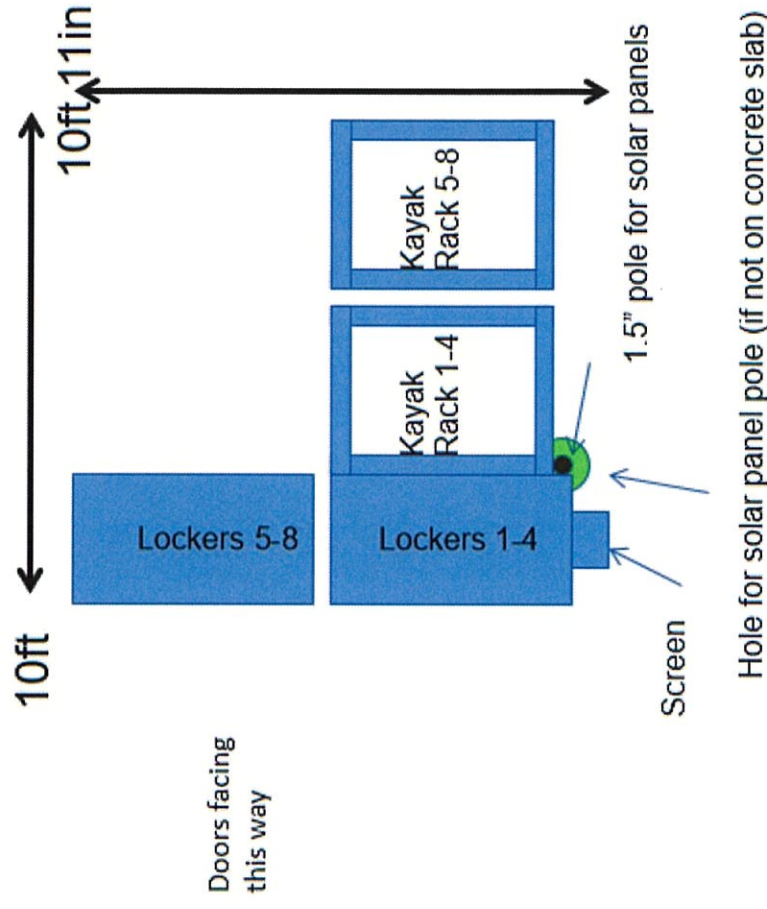

Top View Layout of Kayak Kiosk



This is a general top-side view of what an 8-place Kayak Kiosk looks like so you can figure out where you want to set it. You will need to get the hole dug for your solar panel pole before you set the machine, and once it is you can hose clamp the pole to the front of the rack for boats 1-4 to hold it in place (Pic. 2). It is also suggested that you mount the solar panel to the pole before you raise the pole up, as it is quite difficult to do it after the pole is already up.

If you are installing the Kiosk on a concrete or asphalt slab, you can just hose clamp it to the rack without digging the hole, but it will probably need more hose clamps to help keep it secure.
