TOPIC Oakland County IT Services Agreement Renewal for 2024-2029

BACKGROUND BRIEF:

Administration is requesting that Village Council approve the renewal of the Village's IT services agreement with Oakland County for the following services:

- OakNet Connectivity
- Court and Law Enforcement Management Information System (CLEMIS)
 - Tier 1 User (up to 5 full-time police officers) with Mobile Data Computer wireless access
 - Livescan fingerprinting system without printer
 - Mugshot capture
 - Crash Report
- ArcGIS Online
- Data Sharing
- Pictometry licensed products

SUMMARY OF PREVIOUS COUNCIL ACTION:

None

FINANCIAL IMPACT:

The 2024 CLEMIS system costs total \$9,670 annually (CLEMIS Tier 1 - \$1,696; MDC System - \$1,094; Livescan - \$2,880; and Mugshot - \$4,000). The County provides the remaining services to the Village at no cost.

RECOMMENDED MOTION:

To approve renewal of the Agreement for I.T. Services between Oakland County and Village of Lake Orion for 2024-2029 as presented and authorize the Village Manager and Village Clerk to execute the agreement and exhibits on behalf of the Village after approval as to form and content by the Village Attorney.
