RESOLVED: To approve the Event Permit Application, submitted by Scott Taylor on behalf of Sick Pizza, requesting the use of Public Streets and Right-of-Ways, to be held on Friday, August 21, 2026, from 2:00 PM to 12:00 AM, as outlined in the application.

Public Areas to be utilized are as follows:

- Broadway Street: from Front Street to Shadbolt Street
- Flint Street: from Front Street to Anderson Street
- Municipal Parking Lot P2

Municipal Equipment:

- Barricades at Broadway Street/Shadbolt Street
- Barricades at Lapeer Street/Flint Street
- Barricades at Flint Street/Anderson Street
- Barricades at Front Street/Broadway Street
- Orange cones
- Temporary Closure Signage

FURTHER RESOLVED: To approve the License agreement between Village of Lake Orion and Sick Pizza and authorize the President and Village Clerk to execute the license agreement on behalf of the Village.

FURTHER RESOLVED: This approval is conditioned on the following:

Administrative Requirements:

1. Clean-up of the area is the responsibility of the applicant.

Police Department Requirements:

1. The police department will direct the placement of all required barricades for parking lots and any approved street closures. DPW will provide barricades and detour signage.
2. The cellular telephone numbers of event staff and on-scene managers will be provided to the police department within twenty-four (24) hours of the event.
3. The applicant shall be responsible for reimbursing the Village for all police resources and related ancillary costs dedicated exclusively to this event. This policy is intended to ensure full cost recovery, and the applicant will be billed for the actual costs incurred. This includes, but is not limited to, staffing of the event, time spent on event planning, coordination meetings, site inspections, and setup.
4. At a minimum, one dedicated police officer must be assigned to the event from start to finish. The need for additional staffing will be evaluated during planning meetings with the Chief of Police or their designee.
5. Upon request, the Chief of Police may provide a preliminary cost estimate for police services. The final invoice will reflect only the actual costs of police services provided.
6. Any alcohol present must comply with applicable laws and any established social district regulations.
7. Alcohol must originate from an approved social district vendor and be contained within a designated, approved container.
8. The presence of alcohol in cans, bottles, or non-approved containers is prohibited and will be subject to enforcement action.
9. A pre-planning meeting with the Chief of Police or their designee is required for all events involving dedicated police resources. To schedule this meeting, please contact Chief Mark Amundson at amundsonm@lakeorionpolice.org.

DPW Requirements:

1. Use of Village Orange Cones will be based on availability.
2. DPW will not supply extension cords or cords covers.
3. As always, Village properties will be properly maintained before and after the event begins.
4. DPW will provide barricades for street closures following a request from the Chief of Police.

Fire Department Requirements:

1. There shall be no parking in the Fire Station parking lot or along Anderson Street.
2. There shall be a maintained travel lane for emergency vehicles in closed off areas.
3. There shall be staff available at each barricade to assist with moving in case of emergency.
