**TOPIC** Authorization for Village President to Execute Documents Related to the FY2025 Bureau of Justice Assistance Body-Worn Camera Grant Program

### BACKGROUND BRIEF:

In October 2025, The Lake Orion Police Department has applied for funding through the U.S. Department of Justice, Bureau of Justice Assistance (BJA) FY2025 Body-Worn Camera Policy and Implementation Program. The grant requires various certifications, assurances, and other documents to be executed by an authorized representative of the applicant government.

To ensure compliance with grant requirements and facilitate the administration of the application and any potential award, staff is requesting authorization for the Village President to execute all documents associated with the FY2025 BJA Body-Worn Camera Grant Program on behalf of the Village.

The grant requires a \$1-for-\$1 local match. The Village's matching portion has been included in the FY 2026-2027 Police Department budget and can be funded if the grant is awarded.

### FINANCIAL IMPACT:

The grant requires a dollar-for-dollar local match. The Village's matching funds have been budgeted in the FY 2026-2027 budget. No additional appropriation is requested at this time.

### RECOMMENDED MOTION:

To authorize the Village President to execute all certifications, assurances, grant agreements, amendments, and other documents necessary for the application, acceptance, and administration of the FY2025 Bureau of Justice Assistance Body-Worn Camera Grant Program.
