Greenhouse Gasses - gasses that trap heat in the atmosphere.

<u>Greenhouse Gas Targets</u> - goals set by organizations to reduce greenhouse gasses emitted from their operations or policies.

<u>Carbon Neutral / Net Zero</u> - balancing an organization's greenhouse gas production and reduction to equal zero.

<u>Fugitive Emissions</u> - greenhouse gasses that could be avoided, captured, or used but are not.

<u>Carbon Sequestration</u> - the act of removing carbon dioxide from the air and storing it in plant matter. Technological fixes also exist but are not relevant for this conversation.
