REVOKING RESOLUTION 1325
A RESOLUTION ENCUMBERING LOT 1, TABLE MOUNTAIN SUBDIVISION
FOR THE PURPOSES OF OBTAINING FINANCING FOR
TABLE MOUNTAIN LIVING COMMUNITY.

WHEREAS, the Governing body of the City of Lander, Fremont County, Wyoming, has determined that the Lander Housing Authority is not statutorily allowed to build, operate and maintain Assisted Living and Memory Care housing opportunities in the City of Lander; and

WHEREAS, Resolution 1325, dated March 12, 2024, authorized the Lander Housing Authority to encumber Lot, 1 Table Mountain Subdivision, for the purposes of such a facility.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Governing Body of the City of hereby revokes Resolution 1325 along with all privileges and rights given to the Lander Housing Authority to encumber said city-owned property.
