FOREWARD

WE, THE MEMBERS OF THE LANDER BICENTENNIAL COMMITTEE, DO HEREBY DESIGNATE THESE FUNDS FOR USE BY THE TRICENTENNIAL COMMITTEE WITH THE HOPES IT WILL AID IN PERSERVING OUR WAY OF LIFE IN THE FUTURE. WE HAVE HONORED OUR COUNTRY, STATE, COUNTY AND CITY AND HOPE THE TRICENTENNIAL WILL RENEW AND REDEDICATE OUR SPIRIT AND FAITH IN THIS GREAT NATION AND ITS PEOPLE IN THE YEAR 2076

THE FOLLOWING GUIDELINES DO EXPRESS OUR WISHES AS TO HOW THE TRI-CENTENNIAL COMMITTEE WILL DISBURSE AND USE THESE FUNDS.

- 1. GUIDELINES FOR THE FIRST NATIONAL BANK OF LANDER.
 - A. TIME CERTIFICATE OF DEPOSIT
 - 1. AUTOMATIC RENEWABLE CERTIFICATE
 - 2. CERTIFICATE TO BE IN THE NAME OF CITY OF LANDER TRICENTENNIAL ACCOUNT.
 - 3. ACCOUNT IS TO BE ACCUMULATING THE HIGHEST ALLOWABLE INTEREST RATE.
 - B. THE RELEASE OF FUNDS.
 - FUNDS ARE TO BE RELEASED ON OR AFTER JANUARY 1, 2075
 FOR THE USE OF THE TRICENTENNIAL COMMITTEE.
 - a. ONLY WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE FULL CITY

 COUNCIL AND MAYOR CAN THESE FUNDS BE

 WITHDRAWN PRIOR TO THE TRICENTENNIAL.
 - b. WITHDRAWAL WILL BE BY SIGNATURE OF THE MAYOR
 AND CITY CLERK OR EQUIVILANT.
 - 2. THE FIRST NATIONAL BANK SHALL NOTIFY IN WRITING THAT THESE FUNDS ARE ON DEPOSIT, WHAT THE FUNDS ARE VALUED AT AND THAT THE FUND IS ELEGIBLE FOR WITHDRAWAL ON OR AFTER JANUARY 1, 2075.
 - a. THIS WILL BE DONE WITHIN 30 DAYS PRIOR TO JULY 1,2074.

- II. GUIDELINES FOR THE CITY OF LANDER FOR THE WITHDRAWAL

 OF THE TRICENTENNIAL FUND AND THE ASSIGNMENT OF THE FUND.
 - A. WITHDRAWAL OF THE TRICENTENNIAL FUND.
 - THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL WILL APPROVE THE WITHDRAWAL OF THE FUND.
 - 2. THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL WILL SET UP AN ACCOUNT FOR THE FUND TO BE READY FOR USE.
 - B. ASSIGNMENT OF THE TRICENTENNIAL FUND.
 - 1. THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL WILL DESIGNATE A
 CHAIRMAN AND FIVE (5) COMMITTEEPERSONS, OTHER
 THAN CITY OFFICIALS TO SERVE AS A TRICENTENNIAL
 COMMITTEE.
 - C. ON OR BEFORE JUNE 31, 2078, THE CITY COUNCIL SHALL SEE
 TO IT, THAT THE STATE OF WYOMING AUDITORS OR EQUIVILANT
 SHALL AUDIT THE PROJECTS AND USE THESE FUNDS TO SEE
 THAT THE FUND WAS USED IN CONFORMANCE WITH THE GUIDELINES SET.

III. GUIDELINES FOR THE TRICENTENNIAL COMMITTEE

- A. FUNDS MUST BE USED FOR THE TRICENTENNIAL CELEBRATION
 AND RELATED PROJECTS IN THE LANDER TRADE AREA.
- B. THE TRICENTENNIAL FUND SHALL BE USED FOR THE FOLLOWING CATAGORIES AND NO MORE THAN 25% OF THE TOTAL FUND SHALL BE USED FOR EACH CATAGORY.
 - HISTORICAL PROJECTS: SUCH AS RESTORATION, PRESERVATION
 OF HISTORICAL ARTIFACTS, THAT ARE AT LEAST 100 YEARS
 OLD.
 - 3. PROJECTS FOR THE FUTURE: SUCH AS TIME CAPSULES, MUSEUMS MOVIES, PRINTED MATERIALS AND SIMILAR PROJECTS.
 - 4. THE REMAINDER OF THE FUND SHALL BE USED FOR TRICENTENNIAL PROJECTS AT THE DISCRESSION OF THE TRICENTENNIAL COMMITTEE.
- C. THE TRICENTENNIAL FUND IS TO BE USED ONLY FOR NON-PROFIT PROJECTS.
- D. PROJECTS THAT ARE FUNDED BY THE TRICENTENNIAL FUND MUST BE COMPLETED BY DECEMBER 31, 2077
- IV. THERE IS IN STORAGE AT THE FIRST NATIONAL BANK OF LANDER A
 SEALED BOX CONTAINING ENVELOPE COVERS THAT THE BICENTENNIAL
 COMMITTEE HAD PRINTED AS A BICENTENNIAL PROJECT. THESE ARE
 TO BE USED AT THE DISCRESSION OF THE TRICENTENNIAL COMMITTEE
 FOR ANY PROJECT THEY FEEL NECESSARY.
