

ORDINANCE 1218

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 12-1-3  
OF THE LANDER CITY CODES TO SET TIMES  
FOR REGULAR COUNCIL MEETINGS AND WORK SESSIONS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF LANDER, FREMONT  
COUNTY, WYOMING:

**SECTION 1:** Section 12-1-3 of the Lander City Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

**12-1-3 Council Meetings.** - Regular meetings of the City Council of the City of Lander may be held on the second and fourth Tuesday of each month at the City Hall. Work sessions of the City Council may be held on all other Tuesdays of the month at the City Hall. In the event there is no business that needs to be conducted by the City Council at either a regular meeting or at a work session, the meeting may be canceled. A regular meeting, special meeting, or any other City Council meeting may be convened at any other time or place with proper public notice. The times, dates, and locations for regular meetings and work sessions of the City Council shall be established by resolution.

**SECTION 2:** This ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as required by law and the ordinances of the City of Lander.




