



TOWN OF LANDIS RESOLUTION ACCEPTING RESTITUTION PAYMENTS

WHEREAS, the Town of Landis Board of Aldermen is committed to upholding the legal obligations and responsibilities within the jurisdiction; and

WHEREAS, a court order or other legal document directs the payment of restitution to The Town of Landis, serving to reimburse the Town for financial losses or damages caused by unlawful acts; and

WHEREAS, the court has ordered a payment of \$143,261.74 as restitution in case number 20CRS000581, and case number 20CRSS000587; and

WHEREAS, it is the responsibility of the Town of Landis Board of Aldermen to create a restricted line item account to ensure the availability and protection of these funds; and;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF LANDIS:

That the Town of Landis Board of Aldermen hereby accepts the restitution payment of \$143,261.74, as directed by the court in case number 20CRS000581, and case number 20CRSS000587.

The Board of Aldermen hereby authorizes the establishment of a Restricted Restitution Reimbursement Line Item Account.

The restricted line item account shall be used exclusively for the purpose of improving town quality and supporting town-wide projects.

The initial amount of \$143,261.74 shall be deposited into the restricted line item account.

Any and all funds received from restitution related to case number 20CRS000581, and case number 20CRSS000587 shall also be deposited into this restricted line item account.

The restricted line item account shall be administered in accordance with all applicable federal, state, and local laws and regulations.

Disbursement of funds from the restricted line item account shall require formal action and authorization by the Town of Landis Board of Aldermen or their representative.

That Michael Ambrose, Town Manager, or their designee, is hereby authorized to receive, process, and account for such restitution payments in accordance with the Town's financial policies and state regulations.
