Events:

- Senior Lunch was held on June 4th and had 25 citizens in attendance. Staff served Lasagna from Stag N Doe. The next Senior Lunch is August 6, 2025, at 12pm.

Park Operations

- The park staff are continuing trail and park grounds maintenance. We have started the process of trying to reroute some trail areas around Lake Corriher that were affected by the logging. We will have only one designated marked trail that runs from the lakeside to Lake Corriher. This clean up and routing will take several months.
- The park staff is continuing to monitor the lake levels. Lake Landis is staying at low levels, and the dam is still blocked off to pedestrians. Awaiting guidance from the dam engineers if and when that side will open back up to foot traffic.

Pool Operations:

- The Town is currently operating with a staff of 8 lifeguards. Staff are still in the process of interviewing and hiring a Facilities Manager. The pool hours are: Monday Closed / Tues.-Fri. 11:00-6:00 (Members Only until 7:30) Sat. 11:00-6:00 / Sun. 12:00-6:00
- "Members Only Monday" began on July 7th. The pool will be open from 11-6 to Members Only. No daily admissions or large groups will be accepted. Hosting Members Only Monday will allow us to give back some missed time to the members from our altered hours due to staffing.
