## ARTICLE 4

## PLANNING BOARD & BOARD OF ADJUSTMENT

## 4.1 Boards Established

The following boards are hereby established to carry out the duties and responsibilities set forth in this Ordinance and in fulfillment of the goals and purposes of this Ordinance:

- (A.) Planning Board
- (B.) Board of Adjustment

## 4.2 Planning Board

- 4.2-1 <u>Authority</u>. There is hereby created a planning agency, pursuant to G.S. 160D-301 to be known as the Town of Landis *Planning Board*.
- 4.2-2 <u>Membership by Appointment</u>. The *Planning Board* shall consist of seven (7) members, who shall reside within the Town Limits. Members shall be appointed by the Town Board of Aldermen in accordance with G.S.160D-310. All members shall have equal rights, privileges and duties; except as defined for officers by adopted Rules of Procedure.
  - (A.) Seating Members. All members shall be appointed for three (3) year terms except in making the original appointments. In making the original appointment three (3) members shall be appointed for a three (3) year term, two (2) members shall be appointed for a two (2) year term, and two (2) members shall be appointed for a one (1) year term.
  - (B.) Alternates. The Town Board of Aldermen may, in its discretion, appoint alternate members to serve on the *Planning Board* in the absence or temporary disqualification of any regular member or to fill a vacancy pending appointment of a member. Alternate members shall be appointed for the same term, at the same time, and in the same manner as regular members. Each alternate member, while attending any regular or special meeting of the board and serving on behalf of any regular member, shall have and may exercise all the powers and duties of a regular member. (G.S. 160D-301(a)(1))
- 4.2-3 Oath of Office. Any person appointed to the board shall take and subscribe the oath of office prescribed in Article VI, § 7 of the Constitution as stipulated in G.S.160A-61.
