

## TOWN OF LANDIS RESOLUTION ACCEPTING FEMA FUNDING RELATED TO TROPICAL STORM DEBBY AND APPROPRIATING SAID FUNDS INTO THE FUND BALANCE

- **WHEREAS,** Tropical Storm Debby caused significant damage to public infrastructure, facilities, and property within Landis beginning on or about August 5, 2024
- WHEREAS, the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) has allocated public assistance funds under Emergency Declaration #3608EM to Landis in recovering eligible disaster-related costs and rebuilding infrastructure damaged by the storm; and
- **WHEREAS,** The Town of Landis has received FEMA reimbursement in the amount of \$161,660.09 as part of this disaster recovery process; and
- **WHEREAS**, it is necessary and appropriate to accept these funds and recognize them into the fund balance to ensure proper accounting and availability for related expenditures;

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF LANDIS:

The Town of Landis hereby accepts FEMA funding in the amount of \$161,660.09 related to Tropical Storm Debby as reimbursement for eligible disaster recovery expenditures.

The received funds shall be recognized and appropriated into the Fund Balance, increasing the balance accordingly.

That Town Manager, Michael Ambrose, or their designee is authorized to execute any documents necessary to complete the transaction and to ensure compliance with all FEMA rules, documentation requirements, and audit procedures.
