

AN ORDINANCE FOR THE DOWNTOWN REVITALIZATION PROJECT (PROJECT 25-06)

- **WHEREAS**, the Town of Landis received state appropriations in the amount of \$100,000 for the purpose of Downtown Revitalization, and
- WHEREAS, this Project Ordinance shall cover the life of the Downtown Revitalization Project.

 All funds are to be used in accordance with applicable federal, state, and local regulations and must be expended by project completion

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, by the Board of Aldermen of the Town of Landis, North Carolina, that, pursuant to Section 13.2 of Chapter 159 of the General Statues of North Carolina, the following Project Ordinance is hereby established and adopted:

Section 1: The project authorized is for Downtown Revitalization to be funded by state appropriated funds.

Section 2: The following amount is appropriated for the Project:

Banners for all Seasons	\$ 10,229.00
Christmas Banners	\$ 2,626.00
Repair on Town Crier Clock	\$ 9,084.00
Landscaping (Projects 25-10, 25-11, 25-12, 25-13, and 25-38)	\$ 65,691.00
Globes and New Light Bulbs for Central Ave	\$ 12,370.00

Section 3: The following revenues are anticipated to be available to complete this Project:

 State Appropriated Funds
 \$ 100,000.00

 Total Revenues
 \$ 100,000.00

Section 4: The Town Manager, Michael Ambrose, or their designee shall be authorized to make project expenditures and enter into contracts as necessary, subject to the Town's procurement policies and applicable laws. Budget amendments shall be approved by the Board as required.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED by the Board of Alderman of the Town of Landis that this ordinance shall become in full force and effective upon adoption.
