**SUBJECT:** **Consider Approval of the Purchase and Installation of Two MATADOR 92 Wastewater Matting Eliminators in the Amount of \$19,255.19 from CITCO Water**

### **DETAILS:**

Staff are requesting two MATADOR 92 Wastewater Matting Eliminators, designed to agitate wastewater with high grease content, improving flow and minimizing the solidification of grease within our wastewater lift stations. These units are a sole source product, from Citco Water, with a total cost of \$19,255.19.

The Matador units are proposed for the North US 29 Lift Station and the Town Street Lift Station, both of which consistently receive wastewater with elevated grease levels. Each station has tested a Matador unit for approximately six months, and the trial resulted in significant improvements in performance and a substantial reduction in grease accumulation.

Based on these successful results and the operational benefits observed, staff recommend this purchase, from Citco Water, to enhance system reliability, reduce grease buildup, and extend the life of the lift-station equipment.
