ORDINANCE NO. 1122

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE REGULATIONS OF STORAGE AND SALE OF FIREWORKS WITHIN THE CITY OF LANSING.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF LANSING:

Section 1. Chapter 7, Article 5, Section 502(B) of the code of the City of Lansing is amended to reflect specific guidelines pertaining to additional regulations, storage, sale.

Sec. 7-502 (B) "No fireworks shall be sold from any other structure other than a three-sided building with a roof, which building shall be constructed so as not to grant immediate and unrestricted access to the interior thereof by customers. Said building may be a permanent, fixed, portable or tent structure. If permanent the building must meet all building code requirements and must pass a safety inspection by the City Inspector; if temporary, the building must have three sides secured and pass a safety inspection by the City Inspector prior to the retail sale of fireworks. Any structure must meet Fire Code."

Section 2. Chapter 7, Article 5, Section 505(B) of the code of the City of Lansing is hereby amended to reflect the updated definition of:

Sec. 7-505(B) Licenses. Every person before selling or offering for sale fireworks in the City shall make application to the City Clerk for a license to sell same. The application shall be approved by the Public Works Director Community and Economic Development Director or his/her designated representative and the Fire Chief...

Section 3. Chapter 7, Article 5, Section 506 of the code of the City of Lansing is hereby amended to reflect sign guidelines:

Sec 7-506 Retailers, regulations. Signs reading, "Fireworks For Sale – No Smoking Allowed," shall be displayed **within 150 feet of entrance of structure**, and in the section of the store set aside for the sale of fireworks.

Section 4. All other Ordinances or sections of the Lansing Municipal Code which are in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 5. That this ordinance shall take effect from and after its adoption by the governing body and upon publication in the official city newspaper as provided by law.
