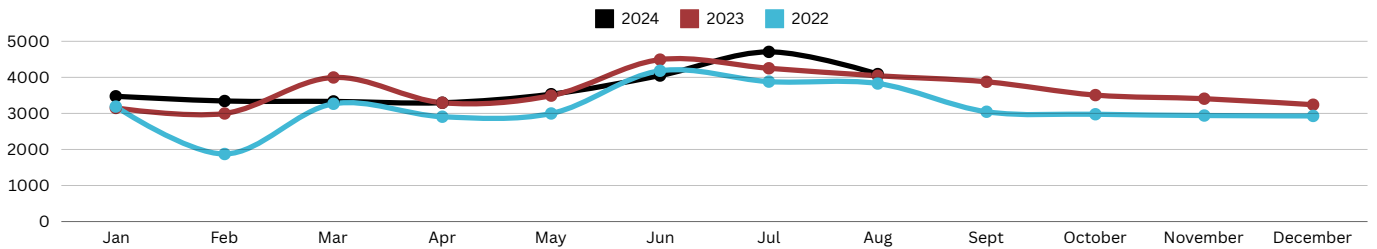
A MESSAGE FROM THE DIRECTOR
