Joint Meeting with Lansing USD 469 School Board:

- 1. Discussion about Drug Prevention: School board and council members discussed community engagement in drug prevention programs in the school. A joint committee was created to include Councilmembers Brungardt and Buehler as well as School Board Members Pete Robinson, Amy Cawvey, and Carla Wiegers.
- 2. Improvements to Pedestrian Access Near Schools: Discussion continued regarding the need for a crosswalk at West Mary by the Elementary and the funding needed. Superintendent Kobza and City Administrator Vandall then discussed that the city had applied for a grant to address the need for sidewalk access from Desoto Road to the high school.

Discussion continued between the school board and council members regarding the plans for the area if demolition occurred and the continued traffic issues caused by the new busing policy.
