Thank you for requesting the comments of the Division for Historic Preservation of the Office of Parks, Recreation and Historic Preservation (OPRHP). We have reviewed the submitted materials in accordance with the New York State Historic Preservation Act of 1980 (section 14.09 of the New York Parks, Recreation and Historic Preservation Law). These comments are those of the Division for Historic Preservation and relate only to Historic/Cultural resources. They do not include potential environmental impacts to New York State Parkland that may be involved in or near your project. Such impacts must be considered as part of the environmental review of the project pursuant to the State Environmental Quality Review Act (New York Environmental Conservation Law Article 8) and its implementing regulations (6NYCRR Part 617).

We note Myers Park, including Pavilion A, has been determined Not Eligible to be listed on the State and National Registers of Historic Places. We have reviewed the project description and existing conditions photographs dated June 2020, along with the memo regarding previous ground disturbance received December 18, 2021. Based on that review, it is the OPRHP's opinion that the planned waterfront revitalization project, as described, will have No Adverse Impact on historic and archaeological resources.
