3/01/2026

260001729- Intimidation - Threat to Bomb

An officer was dispatched to a LV bank on the report of a bomb threat over the phone. Upon arrival the officer spoke to the bank manager who was uncooperative with investigation. The manager offered a 1-800 phone number to call for any additional information. The investigation was turned over to the detective bureau.

03/03/2026

260001789- Suspicious Circumstances

A LV officer was dispatched to a local school on the reports of a school shooting threat. The threat was from earlier in the day, school had been let out, parents and students were no longer on scene. The officer properly conducted his investigation and discovered the student making the threat acted out due to a bad grade they received earlier in the day. The student stated he did not mean it and always felt bothered by the other student. The student also thought they were being made fun of due to this bad grade. The student admitted the above information and stated that they were remorseful and would never have plans to hurt anyone. The officer notified the detective bureau and other officers about the investigation.

03/04/2026

260001809- Lost property

A LV officer took a report of lost property at the station. A resident came in to report that they had found a loaded firearm in the middle of a LV street. The firearm was properly tagged and entered as evidence. Investigation is ongoing and was turned over to detective bureau

260001815- Fraud

A LV came into the station to report a fraud. The resident had received a check from an employer, when she tried to cash it, the bank advised it was fraudulent. The victim still has not been payed by her employer and is looking to press charges against them. Investigation is ongoing and was turned over to detective bureau.

260001845- Assist other law enforcement agency

A LV officer assisted Southfield PD on traffic control for a fatal pedestrian crash. The other LV officer stayed to patrol the city.

03/07/2026

260001874- Assist other law enforcement agency

LV officers responded and assisted Southfield PD, who was asking for assistance in a crowd of approximately 60 people fighting.

260001875- Assist other law enforcement agency

Dispatch advised no Southfield PD units were available for a suicidal individual. When a Southfield officer was available, a LV officer arrived as back up to assist Southfield PD.

260001898- Assist other law enforcement agency

A LV officer assisted Southfield with a man unconscious over the wheel. Our LV officer was in the area when the call came out and arrived on scene first. The incident was turned over to Southfield.

03/09/2026

260001939- Attempted Fraud

An LV resident came in to make a report of an attempted fraud. The victim stated a new debit card was requested in his name along with a request to change his email and phone number to another individual. The victim received threatening messages after the incident. The incident was documented and turned over to the detective bureau.

03/10/2026

260001981- Sudden Death – Natural

LV officers were dispatched to a LV residence in response to a sudden death. Upon investigation, on scene, it was determined to be a natural death. There were no signs of foul play and the funeral home picked up the body of the deceased.

03/12/2026

260002048 – Assist other Law Enforcement Agency

The LVPD detective sergeant and an officer responded to the Temple Israel Attack in West Bloomfield. They assisted with removing children from the scene and securing the scene. LVPD Chief later responded for the FBI briefings.

260002052- Welfare Check

A LV resident came into the station for a welfare check. The welfare check was in regard to a child abuse case. Investigation was conducted by LV officers and everything appeared to be okay.

03/19/2026

260002316- Recovered Stolen Property- Other Jurisdiction

LV officers initiated a traffic stop on a vehicle after discovering the plate/registration to be expired. After speaking to the driver, who swore it was up to date after recently purchasing the vehicle. Officers observed the registration sticker which belonged to a stolen vehicle out of Detroit's PD. Officers took off the registration sticker and placed it in an evidence locker at the station. The driver was cited for no proof of registration and released on scene.

260002347- Fraud - Illegal Use of Credit Card

A LV officer received information of a stolen credit card used at a local LV business. The officer followed up with the local business, conducted a full investigation, and gathered video evidence of the suspects. The credit card company wishes to prosecute the suspects.

260002349- Fleeing or Eluding Police

Officers were on routine patrol when they discovered a stolen vehicle out of another jurisdiction. Officers attempted to stop the vehicle, the vehicle then fled, and a pursuit ensued. The pursuit was shortly terminated as the vehicle had left the city. The driver was not identified, and the investigation was turned over to the detective bureau.

260002421- Suspicious Circumstances

An officer made the way of a local school, the school's school resource officer believed he had a report of a threat. The officer interviewed all parties involved and investigated the incident. The complainant received text messages eliciting a threat, including a picture of a pistol. The student who sent the messages later identifies himself and clarifies it all as a joke. Parties involved wanted to report on the basis of documentation only. The detective bureau is investigating further.

260002422- Trespass warning

An officer was dispatched to a local business over a verbal dispute. The managers of the business had fired an employee, the employee got loud and left the business. The officer called the employee and issued him a trespass warning over the phone, as the managers had requested.

260002425- Suspicious Circumstances

An officer took a report at the station of a suspicious incident that occurred at a local business a couple of days prior. The complainant saw a Glock pistol in the waistband of another customer and came in to document the incident. The detective bureau took over the investigation.

260002491-Animal Alive - Put to Sleep

An LV officer was dispatched to a LV intersection, where there was an injured animal located in the roadway. The animal was severely wounded, the animal was then dispatched and placed away from the roadway. DPW was notified for removal.

260002544- Found Property

LV officers found a knife in the grass of a LV residence. The responding officer recovered the knife and properly placed it in evidence at the station.

260002551- Civil Matter

LV officers responded to a local business on the reports of a threat that occurred through text messages. Officers reviewed texts and deemed nothing threatening.

260002580- Trespass

260002582- Identity Theft

A LV resident came into the station to make a report of identity theft. The officer took a witness statement and the case was turned over to the detective bureau.

260002585- Suspicious Circumstances

A LV resident came into the station to report that large boulders from her yard were moved by someone into the street. The resident just wanted to notify police to keep an eye out.

260002592- Operating Under the Influence of Alcohol / Liquor OWI

Officers were dispatched to a crash where the at fault driver was discovered to be operating under the influence. Officers conducted a proper OWI investigation and the driver was placed under arrest. Prior to being taken to Berkley's jail, she was taken to a nearby hospital for a blood draw. The driver was released from the jail later when her BAC was at 0.00.

260002613- Assault/ Battery/Simple

Officers were dispatched to a local LV school on the reports of an assault. Officers investigated the incident and the suspect had gone through lockers and believed the school had already undergone closing and passed out chocolate to visitors found in the lockers. When she was asked to pay for the chocolate she pushed the individual in front of her and pulled her hair. A report was made, and charges were sent to the prosecutor. The investigation was forwarded to the detective bureau and is ongoing.

260002645- Suspicious Circumstances

A LV officer was dispatched to a local business on the reports of a stolen wallet. The reporting party stated she believed she left her wallet at the business and someone took it while she was gone. The officer investigated and could not come to that conclusion after reviewing video footage. The report was taken for documentation purposes.

A relator reported a suspicious circumstance regarding a house for sale in LV. The officer responding took the report and was informed there was a couple who was deemed suspicious by the realtor showing the home. The realtor stated she had a feeling this couple was watching the house later and going to steal appliances and copper from the home. The officer investigated the incident and the home was provided with extra patrol.
