05/01/2026

260003809-Suspicious Circumstances

An officer took a report from a LV citizen who wanted to document a suspicious circumstance. The reporting party spotted an unknown individual duck down behind his vehicle and run away. The RP just wanted documentation on the events listed.

260003817-Suspicious Circumstances

An officer was dispatched to a LV business, dispatch received a call where the RP stated an employee was assaulted at the listed location. After an investigation the employee seemed to be recording someone at the business and starting a commotion. Video footage was observed, and other witness reports stated no assault occurred. The incident was documented.

05/02/2026

260003820-Liquor- Transport (Open Intox.)

Officers were dispatched to a couple fighting on Southfield Rd. Upon arrival officers spoke to the couple who stated they had a verbal argument and nothing physical occurred. During the investigation officers observed an open bottle of alcoholic liquor, to which the couple was asked to dump out. The officer issued the proper citation and the vehicle was impounded.

260003863-Civil matter

A LV officer was flagged down at the station. The RP wanted to make a civil report. The officer took a report for documentation purposes due to the RP stating he had missed out on his court ordered parenting time. The RP stated he was supposed to pick up the children from school, but the children's mother ended up picking them up.

260003868-Lost Dog

An officer was dispatched to a LV resident to take a report on a lost dog. Pictures of the dog were attached to the report.

260003882-Assist Other Law Enforcement Agency

The LVPD D/Sgt assisted Southfield PD and Oakland County Sherriff's Auto Theft Unit in executing a search warrant at a local residence and a local business, simultaneously. The D/Sgt was there as a local jurisdiction representative and was not part of the investigation.

A LV officer was monitoring the radio and heard a call come out for a suspicious subject near the LV border with Southfield. The officer located the subject and turned him over to Southfield PD where he was transported to the hospital.

260003906-Verbal notice of PPO served.

An officer stopped a vehicle for a traffic violation. The officer discovered the driver was not served a PPO made against them. The driver was notified of the conditions and the DB followed up with the proper steps for notification.

260003935-Civil Matter

An officer took a report for a resident who had placed an online food order and found the business to be closed. She was unable to contact the business for days and they have not been open to the public. The officer later made the location of the business and spoke to the owner who provided a number for a refund.

260003938-Liquor- Transport (Open Intox.)

Officers were dispatched to an alarm at a LV business. Upon arrival officers spoke to the cleaners who were parked in their vehicle behind the building. While speaking to the cleaner's, officers noticed open containers of liquor. The driver was properly cited and released on scene. Officers did administer a PBT to make sure they were okay to drive.

260003963-Suspicious Circumstances

A LV resident has made multiple reports of stalking taking place at all times of the day. The officer documented the resident's concerns. The resident stated that lights get flashed in her windows, heads look in and crowds form in front of her home. She states this happens all throughout the day. The officer noticed cameras on the home and the resident stated they are operational. The resident's sister has control

260003996-Peace Officer Duties

Caller reported concerns that a family member was financially taking advantage of their elderly parent and attempting to have the parent pay for vehicle tires. The caller paid for the tires themselves and requested police presence due to an ongoing no-contact issue; the situation was resolved without incident.

05/08/2026

260004030-Solicitors / Peddlers Ord

An officer was dispatched to a LV residence regarding a solicitor seen on their Ring doorbell. The officer checked the residence, and everything was found to be secure.

260004027-Neighborhood Trouble

Officers were dispatched to a LV residence for a neighbor trouble. Upon arrival one of the parties was upset that their grass was cut by their neighbor. The officer documented the incident.

260004023-Neighborhood Trouble

Officers were dispatched to the station for a neighborhood trouble. The reporting party accused his neighbors of stalking and threatening him for 5 years now. The incident was documented and witness statements were attached.

260004050-Family Trouble

An officer was dispatched to a LV residence for a PPO violation. Upon arrival the issue appeared to be civil as the reporting party accused the suspect of texting her through their child in common. The officer contacted the suspect over the phone and he shared the opposite story. The officer advised the suspect he cannot have any contact with her.

260004073-Operating Under the Influence of Alcohol / Liquor

An officer was on patrol when he heard a traffic crash occur. The officer then located the two vehicles and checked for injuries. After speaking to the at fault

driver the officer discovered the driver to be heavily intoxicated and open beer bottles in the vehicle. The officer was unable to perform SFST's or administer the PBT due to a language barrier. The officer drafted a search warrant for a blood draw, and the driver was later released at the hospital, after the testing was complete.

05/11/2026

260004111-Neighborhood Trouble

An officer took a report at the station for a neighborhood trouble. Two neighbors have been having trouble with property lines and one neighbor wanted to report it.

260004122-Fraud

An officer took a report at the station for a fraud. The victim was a LV resident who was notified that another tax return was started in her name and it was flagged as fraud. The IRS advised her to make a police report and monitor all credit accounts.

260004130-Suspicious circumstances

An officer was on patrol when he ran a vehicle plate in LEIN and the vehicle came back stolen out of Southfield. After conducting a traffic stop and investigating further, the vehicle was a failure to cancel out of Detroit PD. Detroit had already recovered the vehicle but had failed to cancel it as stolen in LEIN. The officer discovered this by speaking to the driver who was the owner of the vehicle. The officer contacted Southfield PD and they canceled it as stolen. The driver was then let go without incident.

260004170-Suspicious Circumstances

LV Police responded to a family dispute involving a minor who had been picked up by relatives after telling his grandmother he did not feel safe at home. Officers advised that the child needed to return to his parent since no custody order was presented. Family members alleged ongoing physical abuse at another jurisdiction's address and were advised to report it there, prompting a CPS report for possible abuse.

05/13/2026

260004206-Found and Recovered Property

A report was made of lost property found at the post office. The property was a set of keys, chains and other various purses/wallets attached. The property was then properly tagged and then recovered the next morning by the owner.

260004201-Motor Vehicle reported as Stolen

An officer took a report of a stolen vehicle at the station. A resident came in to report that a few years ago her now ex-boyfriend, put a motorcycle in her name, thinking she was just a co-signer at the time. Eventually she was receiving calls from the dealership for missed payments because her ex-boyfriend was not paying them. The victim ended up putting the motorcycle registration and insurance in her name. After years of refusing to return the motorcycle, the victim came in to report it stolen. The vehicle was entered as stolen, the vehicle has not yet been recovered as it is primarily driven in Detroit. The case was turned over to the DB.

260004275-DWLS OPS License Suspended / Revoked

An officer was on patrol when he observed a vehicle with expired tags. The officer initiated a traffic stop and discovered the driver to be operating the vehicle without a valid license. The officer issued the proper citations and release the individual on scene.

05/16/2026

260004294-Accidental Property Damage

An officer took a report for damage to a resident's mailbox. The resident stated it had damage as if it was backed into by another vehicle. The officer attempted to locate the cause and was unable to. The damage was documented and reported.

05/17/2026

260004331-Civil Matter

An officer took a civil matter report for a parenting time issue. The reporting party was unable to pick up his daughter during his scheduled parenting time. He needed the incident documented because the mother of the child refused to take the child to her scheduled dentist appointment.

260004332-Assault/ Battery/Simple (Incl Domestic)

Officers were dispatched to a LV residence on the reports of a domestic assault. Upon arrival officers separated both parties and gathered information. The officer's investigation noted injuries to both parties and mutual combatants. Both parties refused to fill out witness statements or press charges. Both parties were let go and the charges were submitted to the OCPO. OCPO denied charges for both and the case was closed by the DB.

260004359-Civil Matter

A parent came to the station to report a custody dispute after being unable to pick up their child from school as scheduled. The other parent stated the school had concerns about possible emotional and physical abuse in the home and was seeking emergency court intervention. A school social worker reported the child had expressed anxiety and fear related to the parent, including claims of abuse, weight loss, and stress-related health issues. The social worker stated a CPS report would be completed. The accused parent denied all allegations and described the matter as a misunderstanding.

260004363-Misdemeanor Arrest Warrant

Officers came into contact with two individuals at a LV park after hours. Officers discovered the driver of the vehicle to have a LV misdemeanor warrant. Officers placed the driver under arrest and transported him to Berkley jail where he was booked and processed without incident.

05/19/2026

260004385-Fraud

An officer took a witness statement from a LV resident who was defrauded of \$500. The DB investigated further and advised the victim that there was an APS report made on his behalf. The victim stated the suspect used an Instagram account to pose as one of his friends and ask for a loan of \$500. It was through Zelle which was attached to his bank account.

05/20/2026

260004406-Suspicious Circumstances

Officers were dispatched to yelling near a residence. Upon arrival officers observed a naked male lying in the roadway. The male was unable to provide any information and was unable to fully get up. Officers were unable to ID the subject. FD arrived on scene to access the individual. The individual would have random moments where he would sit up, tense up and scream with his arms out. Due to that officers followed the FD life unit to the hospital in case of a violent outburst. The individual was turned over to hospital staff without incident.

260004411-Found Property

An officer was notified of a women's ring left at city hall. The ring was found in an old briefcase and could have been there for approximately 14 years.

260004428-Assist Other Law Enforcement Agency

Officers were on patrol when a call came out of Southfield for a fleeing vehicle from an Assault hat had just occurred in Southfield. Officers monitored radio traffic and discovered the vehicle in traffic. Officers initiated a traffic stop on the vehicle. Officers investigated and relayed information to Southfield PD who later arrived and took over the scene.

Officers later attempted contact with the business during normal business hours to review video. Investigation is ongoing.

Officers responded to a LV residence where they are frequently dispatched to for mental health calls. Officers spoke to the father who stated his daughter stated she was going to commit suicide. Officers spoke to the daughter who stated she wanted to go to the hospital. Officers transported the daughter to the hospital and the father followed and filled out the petition.

05/23/2026

260004502- Sudden Death- Natural

Officers were dispatched to a residence to assist the fire department. Upon arrival the individual in need of medical assistance was showing no signs of life. Southfield Fire Department was on scene attempting life saving measures. Later FD determined a time of death and left the scene. The officer on scene then proceeded with a death investigation. The family stated the deceased had a long history of medical problems along with their old age. After observing no signs of foul play and speaking to the medical examiner the deceased was released to the family.

260004505-Found Dog

Officers were on patrol when they were approached by a white/grey colored "husky" dog. The dog was very friendly and was taken to the station where officers were able to get ahold of the owner later in the day.

260004535-Suspicious Circumstances

A resident wanted to make a report after finding furniture left on their property overnight. An officer observed the items and minor tire tracks. They attempted to contact a nearby residence possibly connected to the incident, and documented the complaint.

She provided cellphone video showing a male returning to his vehicle after the incident. A report was completed to document the ongoing issue and inform other officers.
