August 2026

08/01/2026

260007060-License/Title/Registration

An officer stopped a vehicle for speeding and driving with an expired registration. After further investigation the plate comes back to a vehicle that was junked earlier this year. The driver was issued the proper citation and released on scene.

08/02/2026

260007082-DWLS OPS License Suspended / Revoked

An officer was dispatched to a LV neighborhood for someone handing out fliers and driving around without a plate. The officer arrived and confirmed the vehicle had no plate; the driver was also discovered to be unlicensed. The officer issued the proper citations and she was released on scene.

An officer visited a resident for a welfare check through LVPD's Adopt-a-senior program. The officer was notified that it should be a face to face visit. The officer arrived to the residence. It seemed like the resident's welfare was okay as noted in the report.

260007259-Found Property

An officer at the station took two lost debt cards found in a grassy area off of a main road. The officer took the two cards and placed them into the evidence locker with proper care. The officer also attempted to contact the owner of the cards, with no success.

08/08/2026

260007323-Assist Other Law Enforcement Agency

Officer assisted a nearby jurisdiction by providing them a blood draw kit, as they were on an OWI and had none.

260007324-Assist Other Law Enforcement Agency

Southfield PD had a shooting that ended up with one fatality. Upon arrival Southfield requested mutual aid, several other departments aided the scene. LV had one officer assist the scene.

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260007326-Operating Under the Influence of Alcohol / Liquor OWI 2nd Offense

An officer observed a vehicle stalled and blocking on the roadway. The officer noticed some damage to the vehicle and asked the driver about it. The officer started to suspect the driver was under the influence. The officer instructed the driver to perform SFST's and later to submit to a PBT which resulted in a BAC of .138. She was placed under arrest and taken to the hospital for a blood draw. After completion of the blood draw she was taken to Berkley jail without incident.

260007335 & 260007334-Agg/Fel Assault-Family-Gun-Domestic

Officers on day shift were tied up at a traffic crash involving an injury. Dispatch advised the next shift there was a domestic holding. When officers arrived, they spoke to the father in the household who stated all involved parties had left as he was not dealing with them. Officers were able to get ahold of each party that was involved over the phone. Each party had similar stories indicating an assault occurred between the sisters in the residence. The father was not happy with the outcome and eventually got involved, bringing a gun out. CPS was advised to investigate. All charges were later denied by the OCPO.

08/11/2026

260007414-Protective Services Referral (CPS/APS)

Officers made a LV residence for a LEN report from Southfield PD. The officer made the residence and spoke to the mother who stated she wanted no assistance. The child was in a safe environment and the officer documented his findings.

260007429-Fatal Traffic Crash

Officers responded to a traffic crash involving a motorcycle vs an SUV. The driver of the motorcycle was lying in the road upon arrival of the first officer. Life saving measures were started and the driver was transported to the hospital where he was pronounced deceased. Officers made the proper notifications and had Oakland County's crash investigation team make the scene. The LV officer completed the crash report and determined the motorcycle to be the at fault driver.

08/14/2026

260007563-Vagrant

Officers were made aware of a vagrant possible leaving in an abandoned property. Construction workers noticed cameras turned away and the alarm pulled out the wall. Officers checked the building and did not find anyone living inside.

260007575-Traffic Complaint / Vehicle Impound

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An officer stopped a vehicle for having no insurance and LEIN showing: confiscate plate- fraudulent insurance. The officer impounded the vehicle without incident, confiscated the plate and released the driver on scene.

08/15/2026

260007616-Found Property

Officers were dispatched to a found pistol in the roadway. Officers retrieved the pistol and properly tagged it and stored it at the station. It was brought to the Oakland County crime lab for open shoots.

08/17/2026

260007690 & 260007706-Larceny-Personal Property from Vehicle-LFA

Officers were dispatched for an LFA that occurred overnight. The vehicle was unlocked and approximately 9 credit/debit cards were stolen and used. The detective had later made contact with an owner of a gas station where the card was used, requesting video footage. The detective viewed the footage and later identified the suspect and requested a warrant from OCPO. The other case was an LFA of a phone from another residence in which the victims were able to retrieve the phone due to having its location. The suspect gave it back and was also identified through that interaction.

260007699-B&E-Burglary-Forced Entry-Non-Residence

A B&E report was created for the same abandoned building searched by Officer's earlier, with no suspect information. Officers were advised there is overnight security but break ins have continued.

260007701-Family Trouble

Officer were dispatched to a family trouble where both parties had assaulted each other. Both parties had fought with and in front of a 2-year-old child. The child had between them while they were physically fighting at some points. The altercation started when the mother of the child was "disciplining" the child with approximately 3 smacks to the head. The other party told her to stop or she would fight her. Two separate physical altercations ensued from then. The parties were later separated by officers and made sure the mother would be leaving the residence for a while. Warrant request was sent OCPO and denied. Officers did proper follow up with CPS and all the investigating they could.

260007827-Larceny -Personal Property from Vehicle

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Officers took a report of an LFA that occurred overnight. The victim was missing credit/debit cards, with charges soon following. Officers canvased the neighborhood for potential video footage. Investigation is ongoing.

260007831-Larceny-From Yards (Grounds Surrounding a Building)

An officer was dispatched to a Larceny of a trailer. Officers took the information down for the trailer and the plate that was last attached. Officers attempted to investigate any sightings for the plate and results were negative. The trailer was entered as stolen.

The RP stated she noticed a pickup truck waiting outside the business after hours. When asking other employees through regular hours of the day she determined it was the owner. The RP wanted to make a report as it was unusual the owner would be there if she was instructed to lock up.

An officer made a valid traffic stop and discovered the driver to be operating with a suspended license. The driver was issued the proper citation and released on scene.

260007920-Assault/ Battery/Simple

Officers were dispatched to a residence for an unknown problem. Dispatch provided that the RP was saying the stepson needed to leave before disconnecting. Upon arrival officers spoke to both parties separately. One party involved indicated a minor assault occurred when he was face to face with the RP and was pushed. Officers advised both parties to separate for the time being and wrote the report up for the OCPO to decide on any charges.

An officer was monitoring traffic when he observed a motorcycle speeding. The officer attempted to stop the motorcycle with no plate attached. The motorcycle proceeded to flee. The Officer terminated the pursuit for public safety. The officer was unable to identify the driver or bike.

An officer was made aware at the station that a resident's sons requested a welfare check at the residence because their father has dementia. The officer arrived at the home and made contact with the resident who appeared to be doing well. The officer left the scene without incident and documented the check.

An officer was monitoring traffic when he discovered a vehicle with tints that parked at a nearby gas station. The officer discovered the driver was suspended and the vehicle to be uninsured. The officer also discovered other warrants attached to the driver. The officer decided to impound the vehicle. The officer asked the driver to step out, to which he refused and jumped into the rear seat. Officers later discovered a holster and handgun in the inventory of the vehicle. The driver was transported to jail where he was booked and lodged without incident.
