RE: Weather-Related Chipping Policy

Background Brief: Following the City Council’s decision to discontinue routine curbside chipping services, the City has developed a proposed Weather-Related Chipping Emergency Policy to establish a clear process for responding to significant storm events that generate widespread tree and large branch debris.

The intent of the policy is not to reinstate routine chipping services, but rather to provide the City with a defined mechanism to temporarily deploy contracted chipping services when a severe weather event creates a volume of debris that exceeds what residents and normal municipal operations can reasonably address.
