To Whom It May Concern:

Your organization, Redico, and the U.S. General Services Administration have entered into a lease agreement for office space to be used by the Office of the Principal Legal Advisor, which serves as the legal counsel for U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE). Given the recent events in cities like Minneapolis, Chicago, Portland, and others, this lease agreement has generated apprehension within our community. While this lease space is intended to be used as a law office, in light of recent events, simply mentioning ICE raises the anxiety level of the community. A significant factor driving this anxiety is that there are many unknowns surrounding this agreement and the inability of community residents to get even their basic questions answered because of these unknowns, rumors, and misinformation that are spreading, which induces further anxiety that continually intensifies over time.

While I realize this lease is a private agreement between you and your tenant, our City Council believes that providing the community with an opportunity to hear from you directly and to be able to ask some basic questions will go a long way toward reducing the anxiety level. As an elected official, I regularly observe how transparency can go a long way toward quelling anxiety, eliminating rumors, and stopping the spread of misinformation.

To help lower the anxiety level of the community, the City of Lathrup Village would like to invite Redico to conduct a Town Hall meeting in our City's Community Room. The purpose of this Town Hall would be to allow you to discuss this arrangement to the extent that you can, and to allow the community to ask questions in an orderly manner. The City is offering to provide you with a safe space to engage the community in productive dialogue regarding the lease.

While the building at One Town Square is not in Lathrup Village, the City of Lathrup Village is located entirely within Southfield, and our communities are interlinked.
