In an effort to provide consistent updates to the DDA Board of Directors, City Administrator, and City Council the following monthly is submitted for your review.

COVID-19 Resources

• A resource page has been created: http://www.lathrupvillage.org/how_do_i/resources.php. There are a series of links to financial resources & programs available to business.

Events

- **Juneteenth Celebration Unity in the Community was** held on Saturday, June 19th from 4 8pm, overlapping with the Art Fair.
- **Summer Concert series** DDA has attended each concert, inviting businesses to share a table. Several businesses have signed up.
- Alley Maintenance week is July 17-25th to encourage businesses to maintain and clean their alleys. DDA staff will have a work day on Friday, July 23rd.
- Road Master Corvette Club Car Show July 17th and August 14th. DDA partnered with RMCC. The first event was at Michigan First Credit Union. The second event will be held at City Hall and Annie Lathrup School.
- Fall Corridor Clean Up on September 25th.
- **Community Policing Event**—The DDA is partnering with the LVPD for their Community Policing Event on September 18th in Municipal Park.
- **Informational Meeting** is scheduled for September 15th from 4-6:00 PM and will be focused on networking opportunities.

Grants

• The DDA was awarded funds by Oakland County for technical assistance, these funds will be used towards creating a business workshop for online presence and marketing.



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- Oakland County has asked to partner with DDA on an SBA Community Navigator Grant. The grant aims to provide direct support to under-served and micro-businesses in the area.
- DDA continues to seek out grants for businesses and placemaking initiatives

Commercial Business/Property Updates

- New Business: 28851 Southfield Road (Fish Market)
- New Business: 28871 Southfield Road (RM Smoke Shop)
- New Business: 26079 Southfield Road (US Rehab)
- New Business: 26780 Southfield Road (Ruby Lee's Honey Chicken & Shrimp)
- 26727 Southfield Road (BP Gas) work is progressing albeit slowly
- Lathrup Village Apartments will be installing the screen wall soon. The final building phase is delayed until Spring 2022 due to material and contractor shortages

Comprehensive Plan Update

• The plan was released for comment to the surrounding communities at the May 17th City Council meeting. There is a 63-day comment period after which PC will hold a public hearing on July 20th and adopt the plan.

Cannabis

- Planning Commission took public comment at the June 15th meeting. A formal public hearing will be on July 20th.
- City Council held their 1st reading on June 21st. A second reading will be on July 26th.
- Staff is working to finalize the scoring criteria and application materials.

<u>Infrastructure</u>

- DDA Sidewalk Replacement Program work is anticipated to begin in mid- August
- Roads
 - Week of 7/12 Update ASI removed driveways and sidewalks on Santa Barbara and installed concrete driveways and sidewalks with some remaining for 7/16 and 7/17. They will also base in asphalt approaches and base repairs on 7/17.
 - Week of 7/19 ASI plans to complete the DPW parking lot during this week. Removals will begin Monday. This timeline feels a little ambitious, but I am optimistic. Rain could slow us



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- down significantly. ASI also plans to begin the Sunnybrook/Cambridge alley approaches, the 11 Mile hump grind, and ditching and top course paving on Santa Barbara.
- Remaining Work Project cleanup and landscape restoration and punch list items will take place the week of 7/26.
- Exterior excavation work continues in the neighborhoods south of 696, in advance of the Sidewalk Replacement Program. 83/315 have been completed so far
- GIS mapping & data collection system is in place to track excavations, fire hydrants, and gate valves
- Water Main Replacements on Wiltshire (Southfield to Lathrup Blvd) and San Rosa (Southfield to Lathrup Blvd) are tentatively set to begin around Labor Day

Miscellaneous

• City Hall, 12 Mile, Lincoln flower beds are continued to be prepped for planting that should start on July 22nd. There's a lot of work to be done, so volunteers are welcome!
