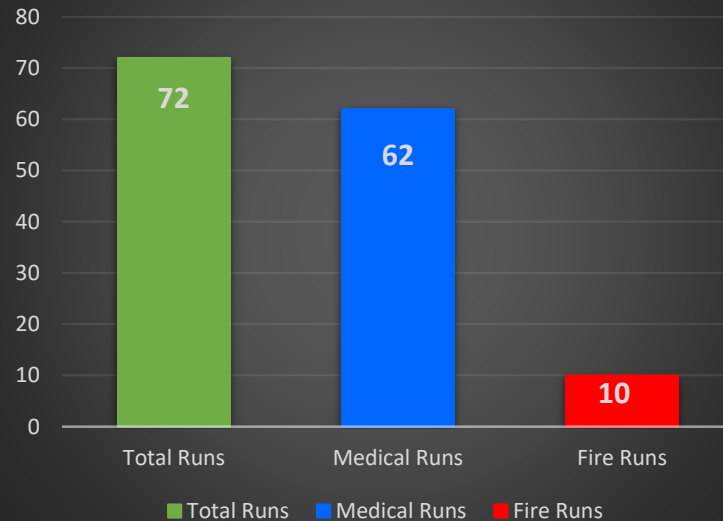

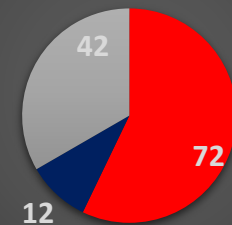

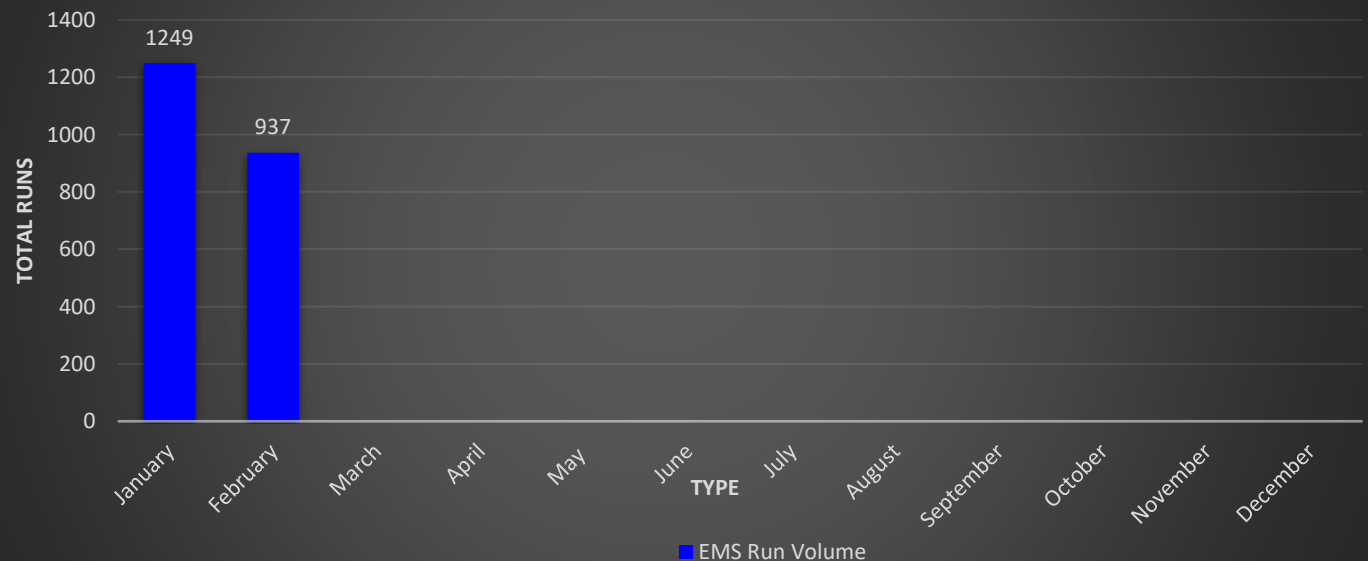

## Training Highpoints

- 🔥 The Training Division continued to work through various aspects of our new Live Fire Training Tower, coordinating between the City's Building and Planning Departments along with OHM Advisors and the Tower Vendor. We have established a firm timeline with the project and are on track to break ground in May to start the site prep with actual installation of the new tower occurring in the late summer, early fall.
- 🔥 Along with the Tower Project, we also finalized our operational plan and fleet mapping of our new radio system. Later this year, the Southfield Fire Department, along with all other public safety agencies in Oakland County, will change over to a new state of the art radio system. This system is supposed to allow us seamless communication between surrounding communities while providing a better grade of service than the current county-wide system. This system will also allow us to access the state-wide system meaning when our Special Operations Teams (Haz Mat and Technical Rescue) respond outside the County, we will still be able to communicate.
- 🔥 We also welcomed a new member to the Southfield FD, Teri Fisher. Teri comes to us with a background in EMS where she has worked for various EMS providers including being a flight medic. The Training Division gave her a brief orientation to our operations over the course of her first week and then we released her to the OCC Fire Academy where she will spend the next 11 weeks learning all of the basic skills required to become a state certified firefighter. Many of the instructors at the OCC Academy are present or former SFD members so we will be able to keep a close eye on her progress. Once complete, she will return to us to complete her orientation before she is assigned to an actual shift.
