Summary: The City of Lawrenceville has requested Kimley Horn to provide a feasibility study to consider the viability of constructing underpass or overpass pedestrian structures in the vicinity of the following locations: SR 20/Buford Drive along the north side of the intersection with East Pike Street and East Crogan St along the east side of the intersection with East Pike St/Scenic Highway.

Kimley-Horn developed concept-level ADA-compliant geometry for the pedestrian overpass and associated ramps with consideration for GDOT requirements and minimizing potential right-of-way, property, and utility impacts. In addition, the feasibility study considered aesthetic value, such as branding/signage opportunities and visual impact on the surrounding community and stakeholders.
