**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE CODE OF THE CITY OF LAWRENCEVILLE, GEORGIA,
CHAPTER 36, SECTION 36-7 TO PROVIDE FOR UPDATED SPEED ZONES**

The City Council of the City of Lawrenceville, Georgia hereby ordains that Chapter 36 of the Code of the City of Lawrenceville, Georgia is hereby amended by deleting Section 36-7 – Speed Zones in its entirety and replacing it with the following:

Sec. 36-7. - Speed zones.

- (a) *Purpose.* The purpose of this section is to establish speed zones and speed limits for the City of Lawrenceville and to replace and amend those as necessary from time to time.
- (b) *Adoption of speed zones.* The speed zones adopted by the City Council and approved by the Georgia Department of Transportation numbered 3830-11-2021 shall be maintained in the office of the City Clerk and shall be available for copying or inspection by any person.
- (c) *Enforcement.* The Lawrenceville Police Department, Georgia Gwinnett College Police Department, Gwinnett County Sheriff, Gwinnett County Police Department and the Georgia Department of Public Safety are authorized to use any appropriate and approved speed detection devices, whether hand held or attached to a motor vehicle, to enforce the duly adopted speed zones.

Except as amended in this Ordinance, all other provisions of Chapter 36 of the Code of the City of Lawrenceville, Georgia, shall remain in full force and effect.
