Action Requested:	Approve an Ordinance to amend Chapter 10 of the Code of the City of Lawrenceville, Georgia to adopt requirements that car washes recycle water and Authorize the Mayor or City Manager to execute the document pending review and approval by the City Attorney

Summary: In 2025, the City underwent a Georgia Environmental Protection Division (EPD) audit of the Stormwater Management Program for compliance with the Metropolitan North Georgia Water Planning District's (NGWPD) Water Resource Management Plan. The plan contains requirements that each local government within the District must meet in order to help protect water quality and public water supplies.

The audit documents were submitted to the EPD, and we received several comments. One of the comments required the adoption of a model ordinance to require new car washes to recycle water. City staff reviewed our ordinances and determined that the City had not met this requirement.

This action will address this requirement.
