Action Requested:	Discuss Ordinance to Amend Chapter 26 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Lawrenceville, Georgia related to Offenses and Miscellaneous Provisions to update and for other purposes.

Summary: The purpose of this amendment is to update Chapter 26 of the code of ordinances to clarify offenses and miscellaneous provisions regulations and enforcement.

Background: Chapter 26 of the code of ordinances focuses on Offenses and Miscellaneous Provisions regulations and the enforcement thereof. From time-to-time city staff review the code sections to update for legality, clarification and typographical errors. This amendment is an update to clarify this ordinance. Several additions were made to that section to bring the city code into alignment with state law.
